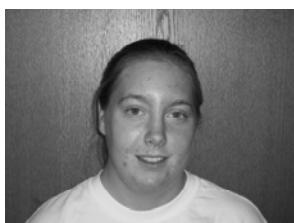


AMSTEMM PEER MENTOR PROFILES

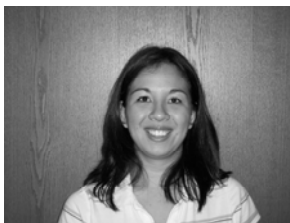
