The University of Kentucky has a mission and commitment to aggressively recruit and retain students from all segments of society, including African American, American Indian, Asian or Pacific Islander, Hispanic, and Alaskan Native students. Factors which are considered in the holistic evaluation of William C. Parker scholarship applications include, but are not limited to, grades, an essay, leadership experience, extracurricular activities, awards and recognition, community service and contribution to diversity. Awards will be made based on the applicant's ranking within the competitive pool. The value of the award is \$5,000 per year.

The William C. Parker Scholarship is a two-year renewable award, contingent upon full-time enrollment at the University of Kentucky and a minimum cumulative UK grade point average of 2.50 or better.

Unfortunately, a William C. Parker scholarship will not be offered to every excellent student who meets the requirements and applies. However, we assure each applicant that his or her application will receive consideration and fair treatment in what is a very competitive process.

Criteria to apply:

Applicants must be planning to enroll on the Lexington campus as a UK Continuing undergraduate student seeking a first-time baccalaureate degree in the fall semester of 2010. In addition, applicants must have earned a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 by the end of the Spring 2010 semester and have completed a minimum of 24 credit hours during the 2009-2010 academic year. Applicants must also submit a 500-word essay on how the student will contribute to diversity at UK.

Students currently applying to or enrolled on the Medical Center Campus (Colleges of Health Sciences, Nursing, Pharmacy, Dentistry, and Public Health) are not eligible for these scholarships and should contact their respective departments for scholarship information.

Scholarship Application Process Timeline

April 15, 2010 – All students must have submitted applications.
June 15, 2010 – All students will be notified of their status by mail.
July 1, 2010 – All students must have accepted awards.
