**ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS**

The Academic Scholarship Office has several opportunities for incoming freshmen and transfer students who demonstrate the potential for academic performance.

**Incoming freshman** whose minimum ACT score is 26 or SAT (M+CR) is 1170, and who achieve a 3.30 unweighted high school GPA, will automatically be offered an academic scholarship, provided the student is both admitted and has the qualifying test score on file with the Office of Undergraduate Admission by March 1, 2012. No application is required.

The University of Kentucky also provides a competitive scholarship application for higher valued scholarships for students with a minimum test score of 31 ACT or 1360 SAT (M+CR) and minimum unweighted GPA of 3.75. International students are also invited to apply for the William C. Parker Scholarships. **The deadline to submit a scholarship application for these awards is January 15, 2012.**
