We invite you to join us for a fun weekend in a low-stress environment! Courses will be flat, friendly, and inviting. Courses will be even easier than preceding years. Great for move-ups or confidence builder. Small divisions, awarding ribbons through 10th, and no braiding!

Entry Fees: \$90 per Horse Trial Division. \$30 for Preliminary Level Combined Test, or ride twice for \$50. \$35/night for Stabling, including bedding—leave stall clean, but not stripped. Dressage ride-a-test for \$15 per test, any eventing test from BN to P.

Refunds: Before closing date, less \$25 office fee. After closing date, only if filled by waiting list. Withdrawals to be made by email to info@teamceoeventing.com

Entries: Opening day: June 24, 2009. Closing Date: August 5, 2009. Entries accepted after CD, IF accepted, add \$35 late fee. Enter early, as event fills each year. Ride times online on August 12, 2009.

Entries: This is meant to be a positive, confidence evoking schooling opportunity for you and your horse.... We want you to leave smiling and proud of yourselves!!! Every effort will be made to help you along the way. Lower levels will be run as no-elimination format. Please see website for photos of jumps and for coursemaps.

Attire: Approved helmet required at all times when mounted. Coats are waived, so a polo shirt is absolutely appropriate in all phases. Medical armbands are required when jumping, and protective vests are required on XC. Have some fun---no braiding!

Divisions for August 15, 2009

Division	Dressage
Green As Grass HT	No elimination! Max height on XC is 12", all SJ will be crossrails not to exceed 12" in center. USDF Intro Test A. Limited to either riders who have not completed a Beg Novice on any horse, OR riders who have not competed above Novice on horses who have not completed a Beg Novice. This is intended for the benefit of very green horses and/or riders who are seeking confidence at this level. More experienced riders may only ride HC in this class (unless entries warrant for a Horse division) to be fair to the riders for whom the class is intended. Not timed.
Starter Rider HT	No elimination! Max height 2'. Dressage Beg Novice Test B. Not timed. Rider has not completed two HT's at BN or above.
Starter Horse HT	No elimination! Max height 2'. Dressage Beg Novice Test B. Not timed. Horse has not completed two HT's at BN or above.
Beg Novice Rider HT	No elimination! Max height 2'6". Dressage Beg Novice Test B. Rider has not completed two HT's at Novice or above. Not timed.
Beg Novice Horse HT	No elimination! Max height 2'6". Dressage Beg Novice Test B. Horse has not completed two HT's at Novice or above. Not timed.
Novice HT	Max height 2'11". Dressage: Novice Test B. May include bank, ditch.
Training HT	Max height 3'3". Dressage: Training Test B. May include bank, mound, small coffin, small trakehner.
Preliminary Combined Test	Dressage: FEI CCI* Test ????. Show Jumping fences will be max 3'7". Will include combination, gate, flowerboxes, etc. \$30/entry, or the same horse/rider twice for \$50.
% Dressage Ride a Test	Choose any Eventing dressage test from Beg Novice to Preliminary and ride that test. Class will be judged, scored, and given constructive comments, but will not be pinned. \$15/ride.

Dressage: All divisions riding Test B for their respective level, except Green as Grass. Arena is 20x40m. Main arena is limestone. If entries warrant, grass arena also used.

Cross Country: Flat to rolling terrain, friendly and inviting. Mostly open fields with some woods. This event will follow a completely different track than our June HT.

Stadium: 100x200 all weather footing with 8-12 jumps. Starter and Green as Grass is run no-elimination and no timing. Showjumping will be very friendly—mostly plain rails. Flowerbox used for BN and up, Gate used for Novice and up.
