***Horse & Pony Wall of Fame***

Kentucky 4-H is celebrating its 100<sup>th</sup> Birthday in 2009, and the 4-H Horse Program would like to honor this by displaying a “Horse & Pony Wall of Fame” at the State 4-H Horse Show. This display will be posted inside of Broadbent Arena from June 28<sup>th</sup>-July 4<sup>th</sup> during the State 4-H Horse Show. If you have a horse or pony that has been a vital part of your 4-H Horse Program experience or has taught many 4-H youth over many years, we want to know about it! Follow these easy directions to apply for the Wall of Fame!

***What is Needed:***

To register, please include the following information on an 8 ½ x 11 piece of paper:

- Photo of Horse/Pony. Photo may be any size but should not exceed the maximum size of the 8 ½ x 11 page. Remember to leave room for a description.
- Name of Horse/Pony (barn name, registered name, or both)
- Description not to exceed one 8 ½ x 11 page (including picture). This should include the horse/pony’s accomplishments, years in 4-H, number of youth taught, and any other information that made this horse/pony a great asset to 4-H.

***How to Submit:***

- All entries are due during the District 4-H Horse Shows.
- The cost is \$1 per Horse & Pony Wall of Fame entry. All proceeds will be donated to the Kentucky 4-H Horse Scholarship Fund.
- Districts will submit all entries at one time only.
