 - Provide an up-to-date financial report for the Management Team.

 - Describe your District's educational activities over the past year (example: Horsemanship camps, clinics, etc.). Be sure to include activity dates, number of participants (4-H and volunteers), a brief description of the activity and any feedback supporting the activity's success.
 - Describe your District's competitive events over the past year (example: Horse Judging Contest, District 4-H Horse Show, etc.). Be sure to include activity dates, number of participants (4-H and volunteers), a brief description of the activity and any survey data supporting the activity success.
 - Highlight the activity or program your District considered to be the most successful.
 - Explain why your District has earned the title of "Outstanding 4-H Horse Program District".
