TITLE OF POSITION: Lecturer and Internship Coordinator in Equine Science and Management

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES: This is a full-time Lecturer position. Lecturers are granted faculty status at UK, but are not eligible for tenure. The person in this position will provide support for a growing and dynamic Equine Science and Management degree program in the UK College of Agriculture. The successful candidate will teach a number of undergraduate courses related to the equine program, develop and coordinate a strong program for internships and student engagement in the Equine Science and Management degree and assist in the advising of students in the program. As part of the internship and engagement process, the individual will need to collaborate with faculty and staff in the College Equine Initiative and with the industry to build opportunities for internships, student activities and career placement.

QUALIFICATIONS: An MS degree in Animal Sciences or a field related to Equine Science is required. Significant equine industry experience is expected. Candidates with experience in university teaching are preferred, and a PhD degree will be considered an asset in our evaluation of candidates. Excellent oral and written communication skills, good organizational skills, a commitment to high-quality undergraduate education, and a demonstrated commitment to the values of inclusivity and diversity are required.

LOCATION: University of Kentucky College of Agriculture, Lexington Kentucky

SALARY AND BENEFITS: Salary open and competitive. Benefits include TIAA-CREF retirement, group health and life insurance, vacation, disability, and family leave. Out-of-state consulting leave is permitted subject to approval.
