**Driving directions:**

- From I-75 take exit 77
- Go EAST roughly 0.25 mile on by-pass
- Take first right onto Walnut Meadow Pike (595) (pass Berea College's Hunt Acres Farm on right) cross railroad
- Keep going straight on Walnut Meadow Pike and cross the intersection with Ellipse Street (Walnut Meadow becomes North Main here)
- Turn right into Campus Drive (not far after crossing Ellipse St.)
- Take next right into Seabury Parking Lot
