Dear Sheep Enthusiast,

Enclosed you will find a registration form for the **2008 University of Kentucky Sheep Shearing School, scheduled for April 22 and 23**. Because of space limitations, the number of participants has to be limited to 12. The first 12 to register will be accepted into the school. Registration will require sending the completed application form and appropriate registration fee to the address shown on the form. *The deadline for the registration is April 16, 2008* (receipt of form and fee).

**Eweproof III is scheduled for April 8, 2008** at the Animal Research Center Sheep Unit. This school is intended for prospective and new sheep producers who want to learn shepherding techniques. Veteran producers are also welcome so they can further develop their shepherding skills.

**Three Eweproof Schools are held annually (III on April 8, I on June 4, and II on October 7, 2008)**. Participants who complete all three Eweproof Schools will have the shepherding skills to manage a sheep flock on an annual basis. These schools do not have to be taken in order (I, II, and III). If you have been to previous Eweproof Schools, please feel free to repeat and refresh your skills at any or all. There is no fee or pre-registration for these schools. They will begin at 10 a.m. and end by 3 p.m. each date.
