TAKE: I-65 to CAVE CITY, KY

1. **Get off I-65 at exit #53** (Cave City)

Then travel to Glasgow...

1. **Turn East onto Hwy 90/70, passing landmark...(Cracker Barrel)**
2. **Hwy 90 east @ 12 miles to Glasgow**
3. **TURN RIGHT onto 31-E (L. Rogers Wells Blvd.) landmark...(McDonalds)**
4. Go west on 31-E about 3 miles.
5. **TURN LEFT onto Trojan Trail**
6. Ends at intersection w/ KY-249
7. **TURN RIGHT onto KY-249, go 3.6 miles**
8. **TURN LEFT onto Bristletown Road**
9. **Go 0.97 mile, LANDIS farm on Left**
