Finca Luna Nueva (New Moon Farm) is an organic farm that embraces permaculture design and biodynamic practices.

It grows a diverse group of tropical edible and medicinal crops.



Finca Luna Nueva is part of the Sacred Seeds Project, which is an international effort to preserve medicinal plants and the knowledge of their uses. It is centered at the Missouri Botanic Garden and Finca Luna Nueva is a Sacred Seed Sanctuary growing over 300 tropical medicinal plants. Other sanctuaries are located in Sri Lanka and South Dakota.
