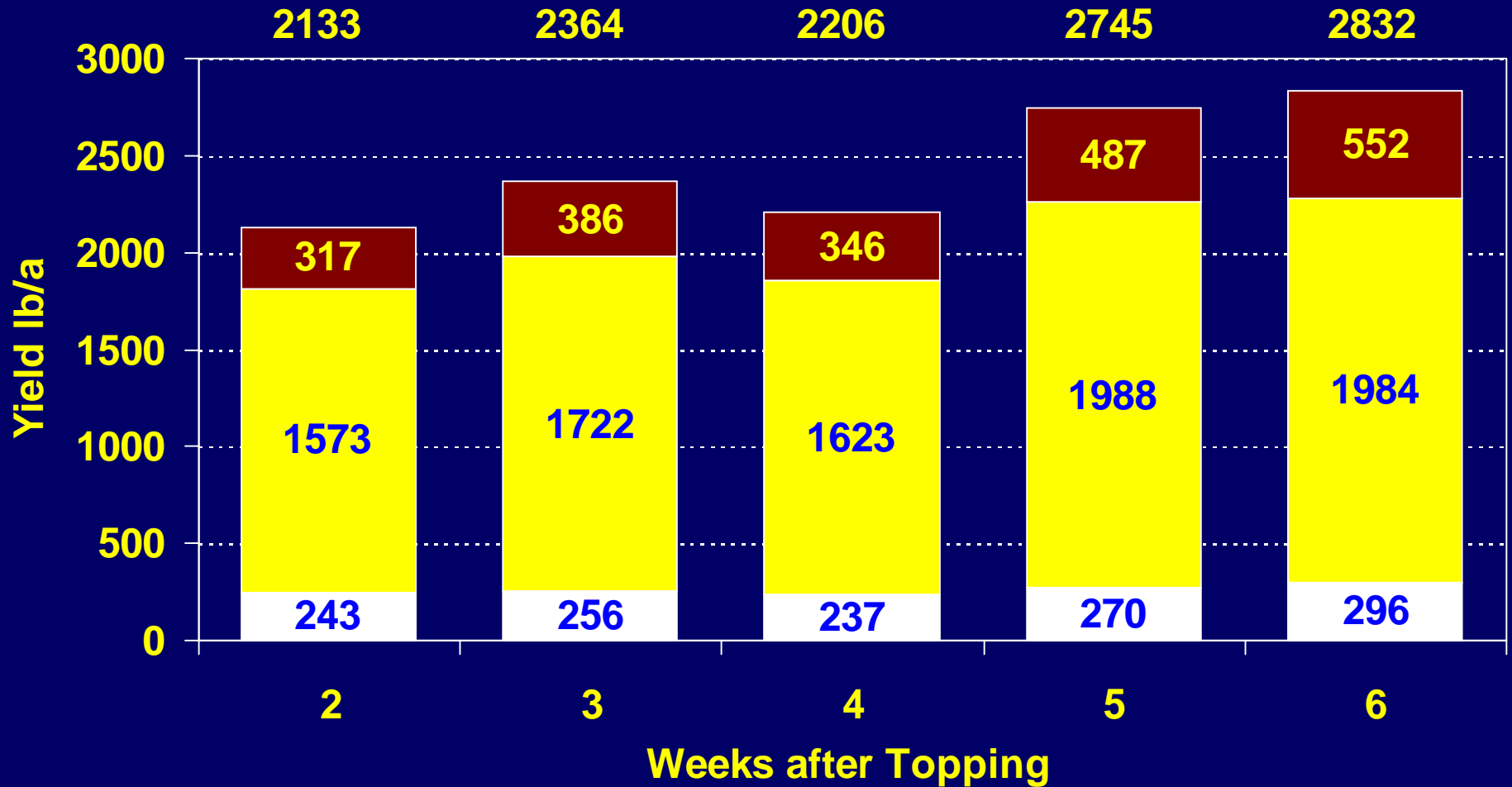


## Harvest Trials

The Grant County test is more consistent with past harvest tests. Under some situations where tobacco has been under stress allowing tobacco stand longer can improve yield. However, as indicated in the Jackson County evaluation of quality, quality declines sharply as time after topping increases. The quality data is consistent with all previous evaluations of harvest time after topping.

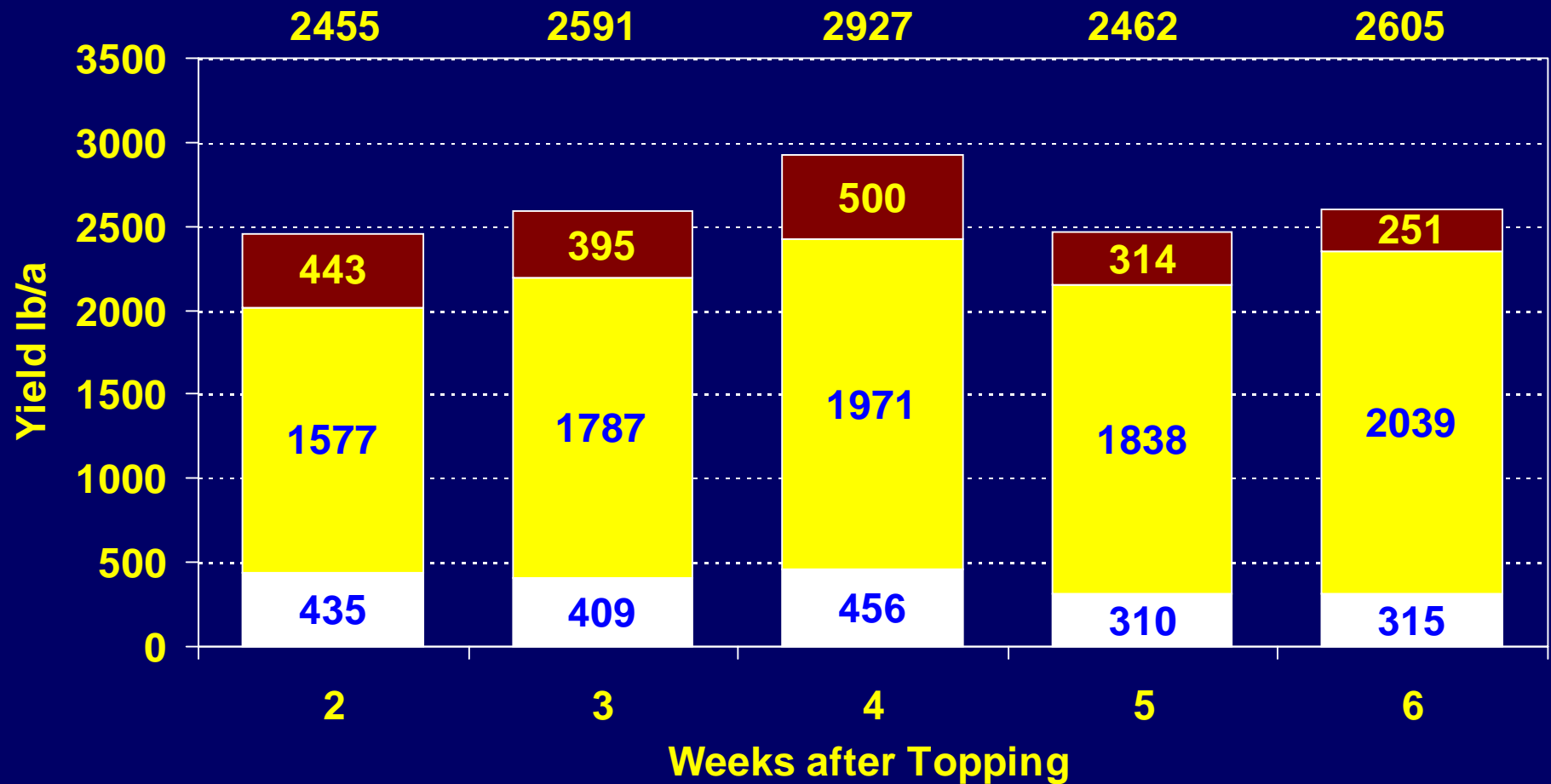
## Boyle Co. - John Helm Farm

# Effects of Harvest Date on Yield

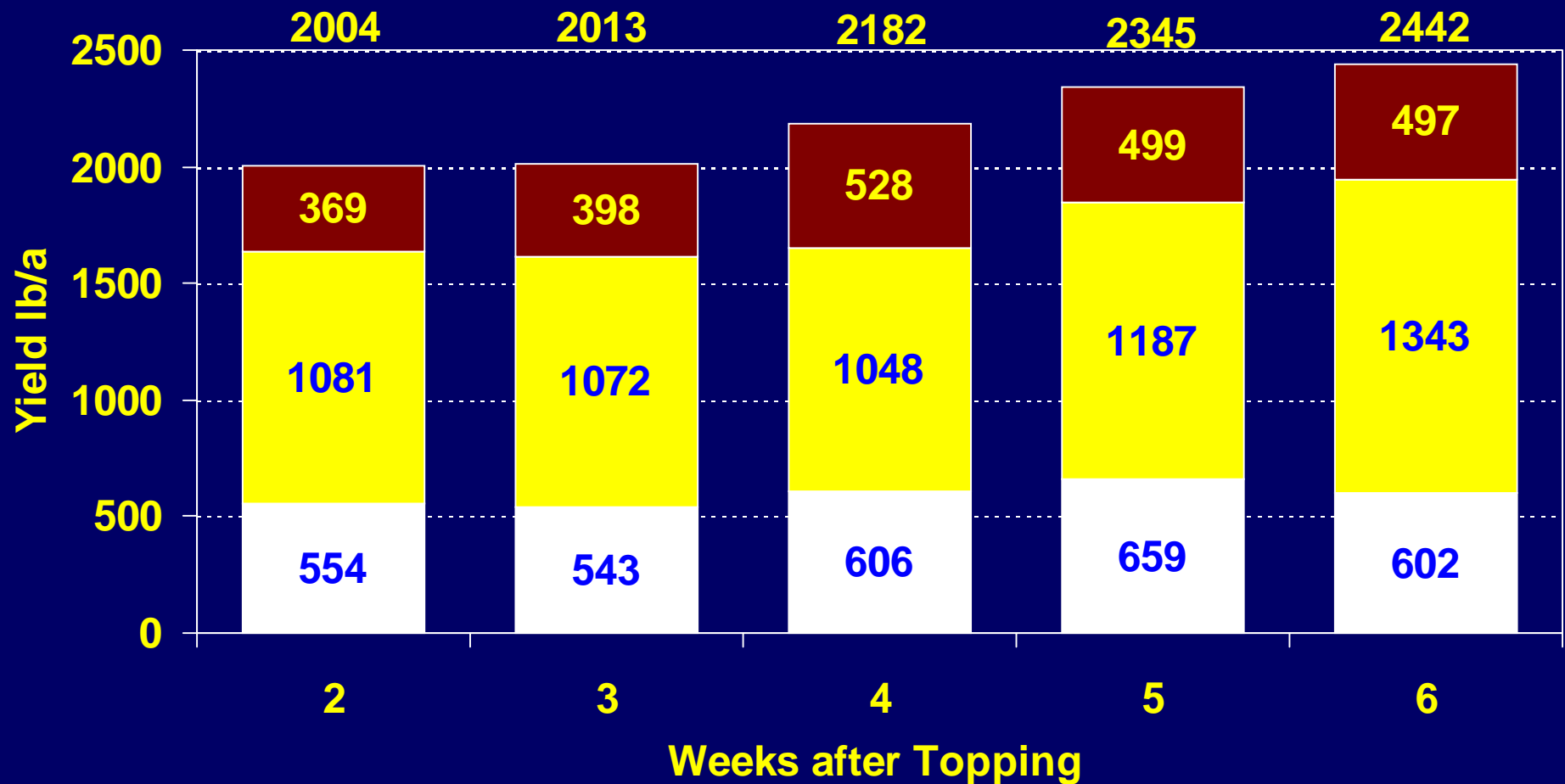
## Grant Co. - Kenwood Soper Farm

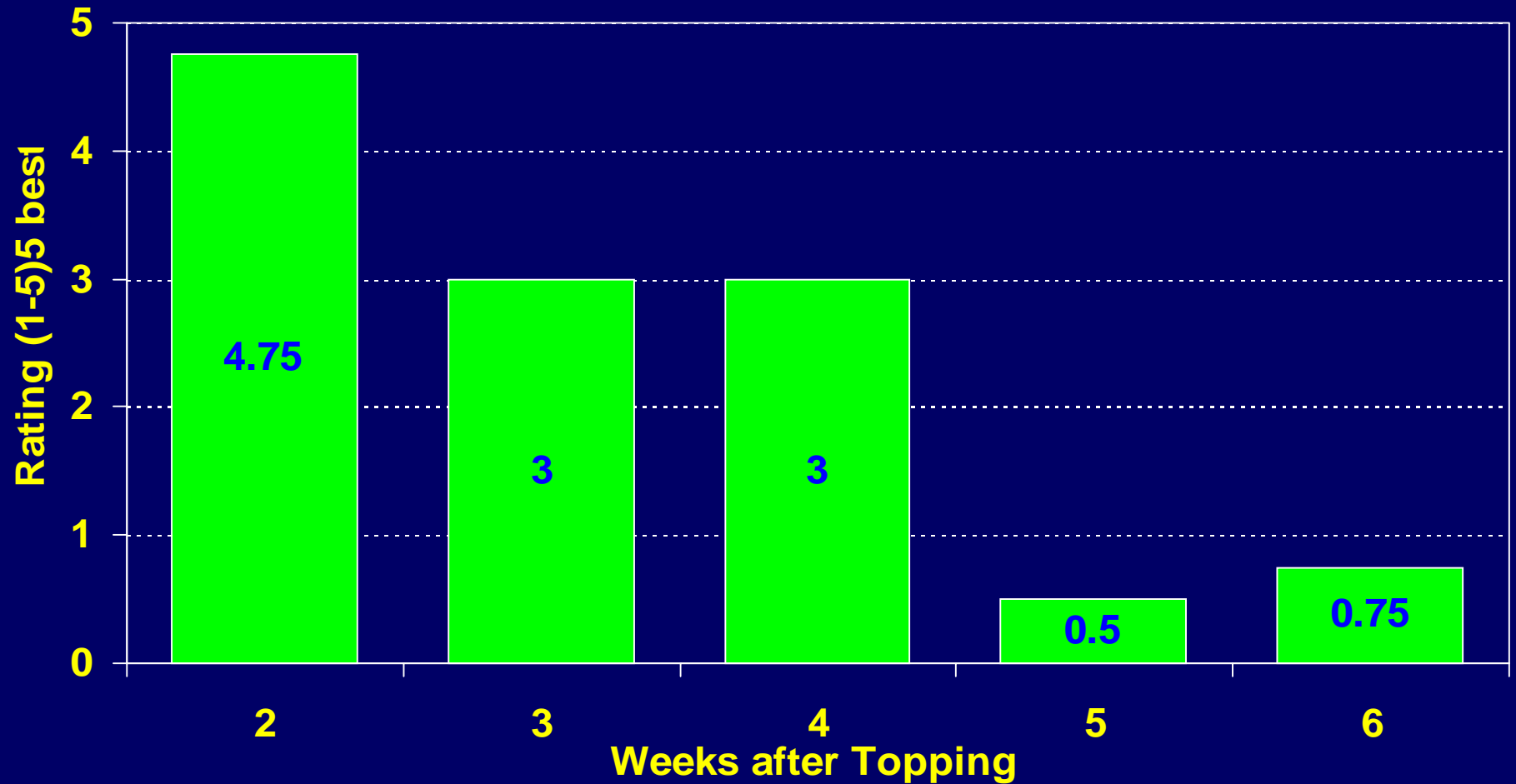
## Jackson Co. - Dallas Truett Farm
