Excursion: *The City of Westminster.* Away from London's busy streets, 1,000 years of history come alive as you explore Westminster, situated along the beautiful Thames. Your guide weaves tales of intrigues and monarchic mysteries as you witness the architectural splendor of 700-year-old Westminster Abbey,

the place where kings and queens are crowned. Walk past the Jewel Tower built to house Edward III's treasures. Traverse streets lined with beautiful Georgian homes, and visit areas where famous political salons are hidden. In the afternoon, make your way through Parliament Square to the neo-Gothic Houses of Parliament. Marvel at the golden spires and statues that adorn the building's magnificent façade, and view the Elizabeth Tower and Big Ben that stands at the northern end. View Westminster Hall and the Queen's Robing Room. In the lavishly decorated House of Lords, note the portraits of monarchs lining the walls, and admire the glowing stained-glass windows that were repaired from their World War II damage.

Local Flavor: Indulge in the British tradition of afternoon tea at the Houses of Parliament.

Independent Exploration: Enjoy a day at leisure or join the Elective Excursion.

ELECTIVE | The Cotswolds and Oxford. Wind your way along narrow country lanes to the idyllic storybook world of the Cotswolds. Breathe in the scent of fragrant wisteria and honeysuckle twining among thatched cottages of honey-colored stone. Continue to Oxford University, the heart of hallowed academia. Stroll through the centuries-old university campus. Take in the stunning architecture of its ivy-clad buildings, and visit one of the colleges.

Excursion: *The City.* Explore the 2,000-year-old streets of London's oldest section,

known as the City. Visit St. Paul's Cathedral, the majestic baroque structure designed by Christopher Wren in 1710. Venture into the crypt to view memorials of great heroes. Cross the contemporary steel Millennium Bridge to stand in Shakespeare's Globe. From the thatch of the roof to the Elizabethan-era construction methods, the materials and techniques used to build this 20th-century theater created an amazingly authentic re-creation of the 16th-century playhouse that staged many of the Bard's plays. Standing in the yard of the 20-sided theater, it is easy to imagine oneself as a

Excursion: London's Tudor Suburbs. From Henry VII's defeat of Richard III at the Battle of Bosworth Field in 1485 until the death of Queen Elizabeth I, the Tudor dynasty reigned. Start your Tudor-era exploration by visiting the remains of Richmond Palace. As you sail up the River Thames to Hampton Court Palace, admire its unique blend of Tudor and 17th-century baroque architectural styles. Experience the grandeur of the palace's royal apartments, Great Hall and mysterious Haunted Gallery. Outside, witness blooming gardens, an 18th-century grapevine still producing grapes today. Lose yourself in the U.K's oldest surviving hedge maze.

Local Flavor: End the day of sightseeing with drinks at a local pub.




