Day 4 | Prague


PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- •Lobkowicz Palace and Museum. Set within the Prague Castle complex, this 16th-century palace features stunning masterpieces, art, weapons and musical instruments from the 12th-20th centuries. During your visit, learn about the legacies of the noble Lobkowicz family.
- Prague's Jewish Quarter. Explore the Jewish Quarter and the Prague National Jewish Museum, a showcase of Jewish history and treasures. Housed in the quarter's synagogues, the exhibits provide fascinating insight into Jewish history.
- •Art Nouveau and Cubism. See Prague's 20th-century architecture including buildings built in the art nouveau and cubist fashions. Learn to recognize the different architectural styles, and listen to historical accounts.

Free Time: Spend the afternoon pursuing your own interests. Visit some of Prague's museums and galleries, or wander through the Old Town.

Day 5 | Prague | Passau, Germany

After breakfast, transfer to Passau, Germany.

Discovery: *Picturesque Passau.* Nestled at the confluence of the Danube, IIz and Inn rivers, Passau has been called "one of the world's most beautifully situated towns." See many highlights, including St. Stephen's Cathedral, Veste Oberhaus and Niedernburg Abbey.

Embark your first-class ship and kick off your Danube cruise during a Welcome Aboard Reception and Dinner.

Day 6 | Melk, Austria | Dürnstein

Discovery: *Melk Abbey.* Visit Melk's Benedictine abbey, an architectural jewel that dates from 1736, and admire spectacular views of the Danube from the abbey's terrace.

This afternoon, enjoy sailing through the Wachau Valley, one of Europe's finest landscapes where the riverbanks boast charming villages clustered around churches and medieval castles.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- Dürnstein Walking Tour. This picturesque tour is steeped in baroque architecture and gorgeous scenery. Plus, visit the magnificent Stiftskirche, known for its blue tower.
- Cycling the Danube. Join a guide for a leisurely cycle along the Danube. See vineyards of the Wachau Valley region, and enjoy a relaxing stop to indulge in coffee and cake. (Active)
- •Wachau Winery. Travel into the center of Dürnstein to visit a local winery in a beautiful old building. Learn about the winery's most popular vintages and sample a few of the wines.

Day 7 | Vienna

Enrichment: Timeless Vienna.



PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

• Imperial Vienna. Explore the Imperial Apartments of Hofburg Palace, and drive along the Ringstrasse, one of the world's most magnificent boulevards. See the University, the Houses of Parliament and the Opera House.

•Klosterneuburg Monastery and Wine.

The 12th-century Klosterneuburg Monastery is home to the gilded copper Verdun Altar. Witness an art collection and taste local wines from the cellar.

•Schönbrunn Palace. Visit the UNESCO World Heritage site of Schönbrunn Palace, the former summer residence of the Imperial family. See the luxurious State Apartments, the Hall of Mirrors and the estate's vast gardens.

Free Time: During leisure time, try Viennese coffee or *Sacher Torte,* a tasty Austrian cake. A shuttle will be provided for your convenience.

AHI Connects: *Viennese Waltz.* Watch professional dancers perform the Viennese waltz. Then learn the steps of this classic dance!



Day 8 | Bratislava, Slovakia

Enrichment: The Velvet Revolution and the Making of Slovakia.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- •Old Town and Café. Discover Bratislava's rich past. See St. Martin's Cathedral, the Slovak National Theatre, St. Michael's Gate and Primate's Palace, where Hungarian archbishops spend their winters, and sample pastry at a café.
- •Old Town and Music. Explore the cobbled streets of charming Old Town, viewing many of Bratislava's most iconic sights, and revel in a performance by a talented young musician.
- •Iron Curtain Bike Tour. Join a leisurely bike tour along the Danube to explore the Slovak-Austrian border, once part of the Iron Curtain. Delight in vistas of the marvelous Bratislava Castle, see a pre-WWII bunker and learn about the area's urban transformation. (Active)

Day 9 | Budapest, Hungary

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

- •Highlights of Budapest. Enjoy a panoramic tour, passing Heroes' Square, the Opera House, the Gothic-style Parliament and Fisherman's Bastion, an iconic viewpoint in Budapest.
- •Living Local. Browse food and craft stalls in the Great Market Hall, enjoy a strudel demonstration and taste the local schnapps.
- •Budapest's Jewish Quarter. Explore the Jewish Quarter, viewing the Great Synagogue and the poignant Shoes on the Danube memorial. Visit the Holocaust Memorial Center inside the Pava Street Synagogue.



Discovery: *Budapest by Night.* Relish an illuminated cityscape as the ship departs.

Day 10 | Pécs | Osijek, Croatia | Vukovar

Discovery: *Pécs.* Discover Pécs, known for its Roman ruins and Ottoman mosques. Savor regional flavors during a wine tasting.

CAHI Connects: Rural Croatia. Begin your outing in Croatia's Slavonia region with a visit to Rural House, located in a small village. Sample Slavonian foods and learn about local traditions while viewing a short video.

Discovery: Osijek and Vukovar. Take a walking tour through Osijek, passing baroque buildings, military complexes and university facilities. This village, which hugs the River Drava, has 17 parks and an impressive historic neighborhood. Continue to Vukovar for a panoramic tour through the historic city center. Rejoin the ship in Mohács and sail to Belgrade.

Day 11 | Belgrade, Serbia

Enrichment: Modern Serbia.

PYJ | Choose one of these excursions:

• *Highlights of Belgrade*. This fourth-century capital is a hub of architecture and culture.





Marvel at the ornate Orthodox cathedral, and step into St. Sava, a shining feature of Belgrade.

- Eating Like a Local. Take a sensory journey of Serbian gastronomy. Taste creamy kajmak, a local cheese, plus other treats with delicious spices and flavors. Along the way, learn about Serbia's customs and traditions.
- •Science and Scientist Tour. At the Nikola Tesla Museum, discover how this 19th-century inventor left his imprint on wireless technology while exploring interactive exhibits, original documents and short films.

Free Time: Enjoy the afternoon at leisure. A shuttle will be available for your convenience.

Discovery: *Folk Show.* After dinner, delight in a lively, colorful Serbian folk show on the ship.

Day 12 | Iron Gate Gorge

Sail past the cliffs of the Carpathian Mountains. Enter the Iron Gate Gorge, one of Europe's most magnificent natural wonders, which serves as the boundary between Romania and Serbia. Watching the Danube thunder through the gap is a thrilling sight!

Discovery: *Frühschoppen!* All hands on deck for *Frühschoppen*, a German mid-morning tradition! Relax and enjoy a spread of warm pretzels, sausages, beer and more.

Join a Farewell Reception and Dinner tonight.

Day 13 | Vidin, Bulgaria | Sofia

After breakfast, disembark the ship in Vidin.

Discovery: Ancient Vidin. Tour one of Bulgaria's oldest towns, and see the Osman Pazvantouglu Library and Mosque, plus other intriguing highlights. Visit the 17th-century St. Panteleimon Church and the medieval Baba Vida Fortress.

Savor lunch and stunning views at The Rocks restaurant. Then continue to Sofia and check in to the Sofia Hotel Balkan.

Day 14 | Sofia

Enrichment: A Prologue to the Bulgarian Revival.

Discovery: *Sofia.* Discover Bulgaria's capital. See the ancient ruins of Serdica, and admire St. George Rotunda, the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral and Alexander Battenberg Square, home to the former Royal Palace.

Free Time: During leisure time, you may wish to explore Town Square or marvel at the beautiful icons and frescoes inside Sofia's churches.

In the evening, join your fellow travelers for a Farewell Reception and Dinner.


