

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIDWAY AND  
WOODFORD COUNTY, KENTUCKY,  
FOR SNOW/ICE TREATMENT  
AND REMOVAL ON MIDWAY CITY STREETS**

WHEREAS, the Woodford County Road Department has for the time that Midway was a fifth class city provided snow and ice treatment and removal on Midway city streets at no cost to the City of Midway; and

WHEREAS, such road service was not provided to the city of Versailles, a fourth class city; and

WHEREAS, to be fair and consistent in this regard, now that Midway has acquired fourth class city status like Versailles, the parties have agreed and determined that such road service cannot be provided to Midway at no cost; and

WHEREAS, the chief executive officers for both governments have met and arrived at an agreed-upon formula and approach for the treatment and removal of snow and ice from Midway city streets, and both governmental bodies have formally acted to accept these terms;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby mutually agreed by and between the City of Midway and County of Woodford as follows:

Area of Service: The area of service for the agreement shall be all Midway city streets set forth in the attached listing, incorporated herein by reference.

Scope of Service and Responsibilities: The scope of service responsibilities for the treatment of roads in wintry conditions within the incorporated limits of the

City of Midway shall be listed separately for the Woodford County Fiscal Court (County) and the City of Midway (City).

Duration: Duration of this agreement shall be for the 2011-2012 winter season.

Subsequent Agreement: The parties will discuss entering into a subsequent agreement between them for the treatment and removal of snow and ice for the 2012-2013 winter season and beyond, which agreement shall, if required, be an interlocal or compact agreement.

The County shall:

1. Utilize the Woodford County Road Department in the same fashion as had been historically done, in terms of the treatment for, and removal of, snow and ice from the attached list of Midway streets, with priority being afforded as has traditionally been done in the past.

2. Bill the City for the actual cost of the service provided (if incurred), based upon the following calculation by the Woodford County Road Engineer:

- (a) Cost for employee hours
- (b) Plow/salt truck usage
- (c) Salt spread
- (d) Final cost = total of (a), (b), and (c)

The City shall:

1. Defer to the Woodford County Road Engineer in terms of how to address treatment and removal of snow and ice.

2. Pay to the Woodford County Fiscal Court in full within thirty (30) days of any statement of costs rendered by the County for winter road service.
