1. Samples of work:

All included materials should present visual acuity and graphic abilities. This may include but is not limited to: a selection of architectural/engineering drawing; painting; drawing; print; graphic design; or photography.

Graphic work should be accompanied by a brief statement of intent, degree of involvement (where not self-evident), and/or the rationale for the work.

Portfolio should be printed on 8.5, 11 inch paper (no binder) and not exceed 20 pages.

Portfolio will NOT be returned to applicant and should not include original work.

2. Three Letters of Recommendation

3. Personal Essay:

The essay should be no longer than 500 words, explaining your interest in Preservation, and outlining your reasons for applying to this program.

4. Interview:

Although not a requirement, an interview with the faculty of the Department of Historic Preservation is recommended. Call 859-257-3030 to arrange an interview.
