Essay + Illustration Requirement

The words 'Interior Design' have both verbal and non-verbal meanings. Verbally, the profession involves the shaping of interior space to suit an experience, a program, or function. Non-verbally, Interior Design brings to mind images that are specific to each person. For example, the word LIGHT could bring to mind something that is direct, mysterious, filtered, or bright. It could be represented by a series of images, which together provide a visual definition of the word.

Provide a series of images (no more than 6), which communicate a visual definition of the words 'Interior Design'. The images may not be of interior spaces or of interior furnishings. In an essay explain why you were inspired by the images. Attach your images and essay to your Pre-Major Application Form. Your images must be original sketches or photographs, not photocopies. Your essay is limited to one typed page.
