

In order for the University of Kentucky to use ACT or SAT test results for admission decisions; we must have the scores directly reported to the UK Office of Undergraduate Admission by the appropriate testing agency. Student or high school copies of score reports, or copies on high school transcripts, are not official and cannot be used. To have your scores officially reported to UK, follow these directions:

Have the following information ready:

- * Student's Full Name
- * Current Mailing Address
- * Address at Time of Test
- * Home Telephone Number
- * Date of Birth
- * Social Security Number
- * Date of Test (Month and Year)
