UNDERGRADUATE OR GRADUATE, FULL-TIME OR PART-TIME STUDENTS

Applicants must be students who are enrolled in an electronically delivered course (online, TV, compressed video, videotape, satellite, electronic mail)

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

A scholarship of **\$500** will be awarded during the 2010 Fall semester.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates must be **students** who are enrolled in an electronically delivered course that is scheduled through Independent Study Program or Distance Learning Programs on the Lexington Campus.
- Applicants must be officially admitted to the University of Kentucky by Undergraduate Admissions or the Graduate School.
- Candidates must have accumulated 12 semester hours or more of college credit at any institution of higher learning and have a cumulative GPA of 3.25 or better by the end of July, 2010.
- Applicants must enroll between March 29, 2010 and August 30, 2010.
- Candidates are required to enroll for a **letter grade** (unless course is offered Pass/Fail only).

DEADLINE

LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED. Completed applications must be received in room 13A Funkhouser Building **before 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, September 22, 2010**. An application form is on the back.

SELECTION PROCESS

The Nofflet D. Williams Scholarship is a competition in which applications will be evaluated by committee members. Members will consider the applicant's: 1) cumulative GPA; 2) academic merit and potential; 3) essay, in terms of content and style; and 4) outside activities, including employment. A portion of the score will be based on committee discretion. **The decisions of the selection committee are final.** Notifications of the award will be mailed approximately three weeks after the application deadline.
