SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Candidates are invited to apply for a \$2,000 fellowship offered by the University of Kentucky Woman's Club, in conjunction with the Graduate School. These awards are made possible by generous donations from UK Woman's Club members as well as support from the Research Challenge Trust Fund.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Candidates must be currently enrolled, full-time or part-time Ph.D., Ed.D., D.M.A., or D.S. students
- Candidates must have passed their qualifying examination
- Candidates must be Kentucky residents
- Candidates must have at least a 3.2 cumulative GGPA
- Candidates for professional degree programs (Law, Pharmacy, Dentistry and Medicine) are not eligible
- Preference is given to female candidates age 30 or over
- Preference is given to female candidates who are underrepresented in their field of study
- Selection is based on both academic achievement and financial need
- Student statement should include information about area of concentration within field of study, obstacles overcome, aspirations, personal characteristics, and how a candidate might benefit from this fellowship

2. A resume or curriculum vitae.
3. Two letters of recommendation prepared by faculty familiar with the candidate's academic abilities.
4. An essay of no more than two double-spaced pages, providing information to the committee in evaluating the candidate's application. This information might include area of concentration within the field of study, obstacles overcome, aspirations, personal characteristics, and how a candidate might benefit from this fellowship.

The Graduate School will provide the following documents to the selection committee on behalf of the department, in addition to the DGS submitted nomination packet (you do not need to submit these items):

- Transcripts from all schools attended, both undergraduate and graduate
- Official GRE or GMAT scores
