CHE 295 – Organic Chemistry Workshop (1)

Peer-led team problem solving. Two-hour workshop offered on a pass-fail basis only.

Prerequisite: Concurrent registration in CHE 230 required.

CHE 297 – Organic Chemistry Workshop II (1)

Peer-led team problem solving. Two-hour workshop offered on a pass-fail basis only.

[Enrollment in CHE 232 need not be accompanied by enrollment in CHE 297.]

Prerequisite: Concurrent registration in CHE 232 required.

B.S./B.A. in Arts and Sciences with a major in Philosophy




