

## **REPORT OF THE UNIVERSITY SENATE RULES COMMITTEE, 2001-02**

The Senate Rules Committee rendered two interpretations of the rules this year:

(1) Responding to a question from Arts & Sciences, it ruled that Rule 5.3.1.3B which states that “students are subject to suspension without a preliminary probationary term if their GPA is below 0.6 after their first full time enrollment at UK” does **NOT** apply to students who are part time at the end of the semester.

(2) Responding to a question from Senate Council Chair Bill Fortune, it ruled that Rule 5.3.1.5 (the Academic Bankruptcy rule) requires that a student must have taken all of the 12 hours necessary to apply for bankruptcy for a letter grade.

The rulings and their rationales are on file in the Senate Council office.

The committee chair and members spent some time preparing the ballots, conducting the elections, and tabulating the results for members of the Senate Council and for the faculty representative of the Board of Trustees. Professors Ernie Bailey, Elizabeth Debski and Peggy Saunier were elected to the Council and Professor Michael Kennedy was elected to the Board.
