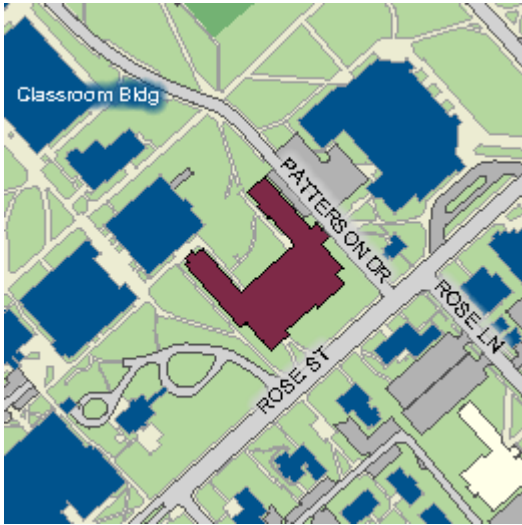

### **Fine Arts Building (see map on page 2)**

- \* Located on Rose Street between the Singletary Center for the Arts and Maxwell Place (the President's house)
- \* Enter from Rose Street (the façade has multiple bronze sculptures)
- \* Go through the lobby and up two flights of stairs to the third floor.
- \* Go up the ramp and turn right down the hallway.
- \* Classes are in Rooms 302 and 308A, classrooms on the right.

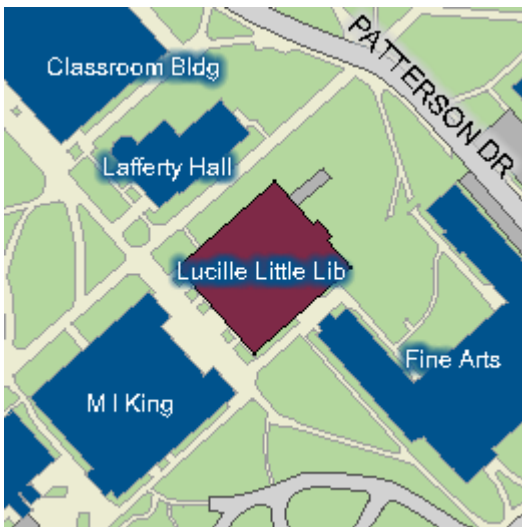
Handicapped access: past the lobby on the first floor, turn left and then right down a hallway. At the end of the hallway is an elevator which will take you to the third floor. The classroom will be on your left. *Please note:* the other elevator on the north end of the building does not go up to the third floor.



Fine Arts Building

**Lucille Caudill Little Fine Arts Library Computer Lab**

- \* Located in the lower level of the Little Fine Arts Library
- \* Follow the directions to the Fine Arts Building
- \* Go around to the rear of the Fine Arts Building (you can take the sidewalk between the Fine Arts Building and Maxwell Place or take Patterson Drive around the other side of the building and go up the driveway behind the building)
- \* The entrance to the Little Library computer lab is directly across from the back door of the Fine Arts Building
- \* A lab attendant will direct you to the lab



**Parking for the Fine Arts Building and the Little Fine Arts Library**

*(visitor parking is in red on the attached parking map)*

If you purchase UK Parking Permits through the Fine Arts Institute, you may park in any E lot (marked purple or blue on the Campus Parking Map). Parking permits are \$2.50 each and are good for a 24-hour period. If you would like to purchase permits, please contact Jane Andrus.

Visitor parking is located in the following areas on weeknights (please note that some of this parking may be paid or metered):

- Ⓟ Metered parking in the circle in front of the Singletary Center
- Ⓟ Metered parking in the lot next to the UK Student Center (enter from Euclid Avenue - also called the Avenue of Champions - across from Memorial Coliseum)
- Ⓟ In the Newman Center parking lot located just behind the Sturgill Development Building (enter from Rose Lane): this parking lot is used by UK until 5 pm and then belongs to the Newman Center; however, you are welcome to park there unless the Newman Center has it reserved for an event, and sometimes you may be able to pay a small amount to park there even when it is reserved
- Ⓟ In the parking garage located on Limestone next to Kennedy's Bookstore (enter from Limestone or Upper Street)
- Ⓟ Beside W.T. Young Library on Hilltop Avenue (please note that the other three lots around the library are controlled)
- Ⓟ Street parking on Rose Lane, Linden Walk, Aylesford Place, and other surrounding areas

### **Reynolds Building**

- \* Located on South Broadway beside the railroad viaduct
- \* Access the Reynolds Building from Scott Street (turn from Limestone/Upper between the UK College of Education and the fire station)
- \* Follow Scott Street to the end and turn right
- \* Enter the central Reynolds Building from the South Broadway side (there are three buildings)
- \* To locate the Metal Arts Building (Metal Working), go around to the rear of the central building. You will see the Metal Arts Building to the left rear of the building.
- \* To locate Rooms 202C, 204, 212 and 220, go up the stairs from the first floor to the second floor (second landing)
- \* The stairs will take you to a large central hallway
- \* Rooms 202C, 204, 212 and 220 are in the hallway on the left

Handicapped access: please call the Art Department to learn more about handicapped access.

## **Parking for the Reynolds Building**

*(visitor parking is in red on the attached parking map)*

If you purchase UK Parking Permits through the Fine Arts Institute (see the brochure or registration form), you may park in any E lot (marked purple or blue on the Campus Parking Map).




Visitor parking is located in the following areas on weeknights (please note that some of this parking may be paid or metered):

- Ⓟ In the parking garage located on Limestone next to Kennedy's Bookstore (enter from Limestone or Upper Street)
- Ⓟ Metered parking on Scott Street
- Ⓟ The best option is to park in Comer's Parking Lot on Scott Street; it is free in the evenings and almost always has available parking spots

## **Weekend parking**

You may park in any non-gated parking lot after 5:00 on Fridays through Sunday evenings unless signage specifically prohibits you from doing so.

## **Important Information:**

-  If you have a valid UK permit, you may park in any lots colored purple or blue on the parking map.
-  If you do not have a valid UK permit, **DO NOT** park in the lots colored purple or blue on the parking map. **UK Parking will ticket and/or tow your car.**
-  Some metered parking is patrolled on nights and weekends; some is not. Please check signage before you park in a metered spot in order to avoid a ticket.
