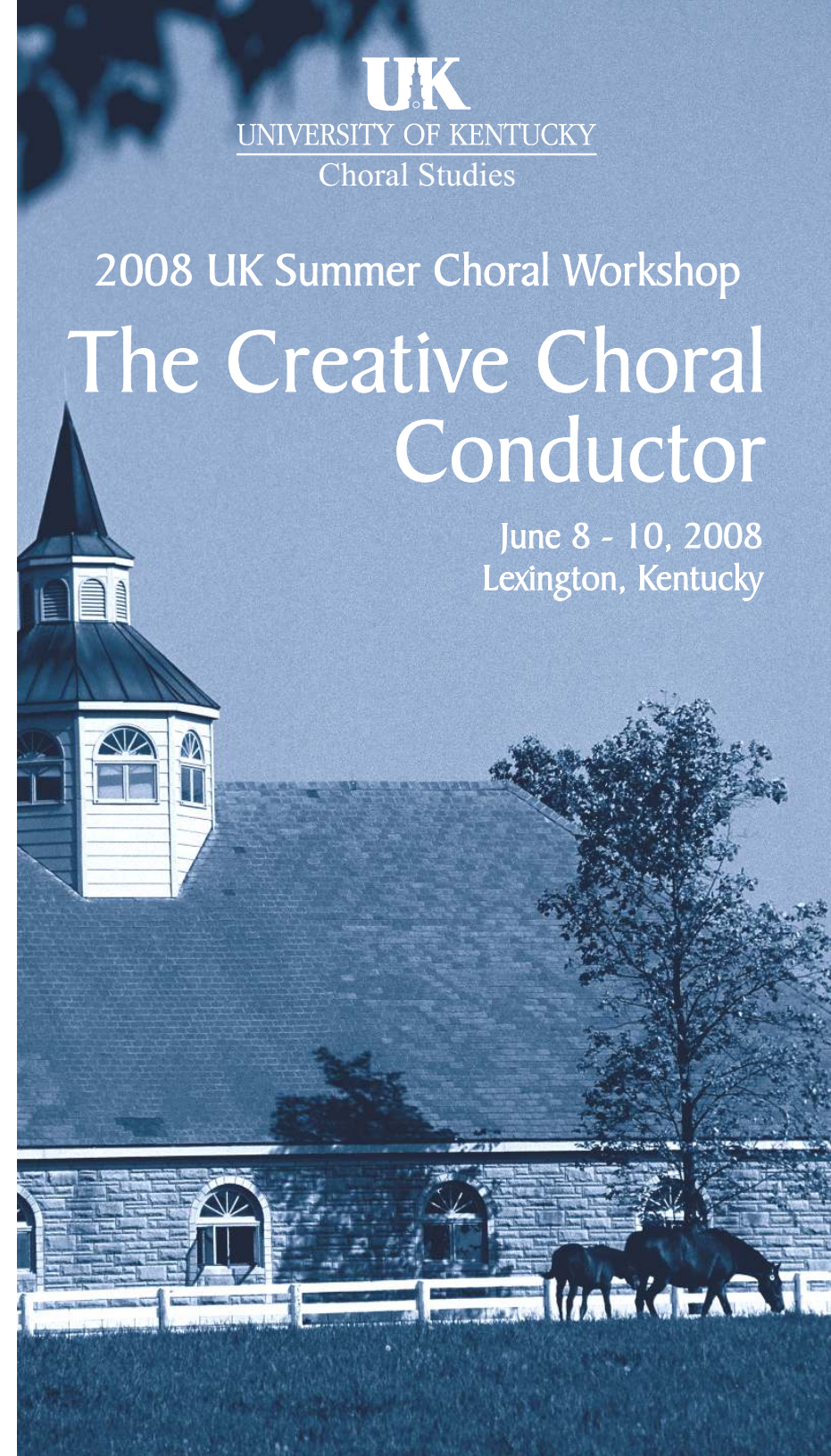

Dr. Dickson is currently the Director of Choral Studies and Chair of the Conducting Division at Texas Tech University in Lubbock, Texas. He conducts the University Choir, Madrigal Singers and the Lubbock Choral. Under Dr. Dickson's direction, the Texas Tech University Choir has established a standard of excellence recognized throughout the world.

Internationally known as a conducting pedagogue through his many writings and workshops, Dr. Dickson has presented

masterclasses before the Association of British Choral Directors, the Russian State Music Conservatories in both Moscow and St. Petersburg, and a host of venues in England, Wales, Scotland, Finland, France, Canada and the US.

Dr. Dickson is a strong advocate for church music. He held the R&S Chair in Music and Worship for the Southern Division ACDA and has led music and worship events for several ACDA conventions. An active church musician for over thirty years, he presently serves as Director of Music at St. Paul's on the Plains Episcopal Church in Lubbock.
