Beginning May 15th and ending October 30th, receive a weekly basket of fresh produce harvested from over 170 varieties of vegetables, herbs, and flowers! All produce will be grown on the USDA-certified organic section of the UK Horticulture Research Farm. All proceeds will go to support student educational activities.

The CSA is open to all UK students, faculty and staff.
