

# **The Honors Program**

## **INDEPENDENT PROJECT GRANT**

### **FOR SPRING 2010**

Limited funds are available to assist Honors Program students in good standing\* who will be working on their Independent Project during the spring semester of 2010. These grants are intended to support anticipated expenses of work (photocopying, purchasing materials, travel related to research, etc.) conducted in carrying out the Independent Project.

**A completed Independent Project proposal (contract) must be on file or under consideration by October 23, 2009. The completed IP Grant Application must be filed by November 2, 2009.** Awards will be announced immediately following the decision of the committee.

Applications must include copies of the following items:

- a proposal, including rationale of how this program or project will benefit your educational or career goals, and how it fits into the Independent Project in progress or planned;
  - a budget (including travel costs, registration fees if attending a conference, duplicating costs, etc. - PLEASE BE DETAILED);
  - a supporting letter from your Independent Project advisor attesting to the significance of the activity to be funded, its relation to the Independent Project, and to the soundness of the proposed budget; and
  - your current resume, local address, phone number and social security number or student ID number.

- **Application deadline: Monday, November 2, 2009, by 4:00pm**

\*- Applicants must be members in good standing in the Honors Program, i.e. 1) have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better; and 2) be participating in or have completed the required four colloquia (three for upperclass admissions).
