STUDENT SKILLS DEVELOPMENT AWARD

FOR SPRING 2010

These awards are being offered for use during spring 2010. Amount and numbers of the awards will vary depending upon the proposals received.

These awards are made to permit Honors Program students in good standing* to participate in an activity to develop skills—such as an intensive language workshop—or, to participate in some type of field-based academic effort—such as an archaeological dig.

Applications must include copies of the following items:

- a proposal of the development activity to be undertaken. This must include a detailed rationale of how this program or project will benefit your educational or career goals as well as a statement of preparations completed to date (application made, contacts, etc.) and a proposed timetable;
- a budget, including travel costs, registration fees if attending a conference, duplicating costs, etc. Please be detailed in projection and cite source of projected costs (how figured);
- a current resume, local address, phone #, student ID # and social security #;
- a letter from the sponsoring organization, or from an academic advisor well acquainted with your record and potential, that you have a strong chance of being included in the project. This is particularly important under certain circumstances, such as when places in a project are awarded competitively.

Application Deadline: Monday, November 2, 2009, no later than 4:00 pm. Awards will be announced immediately following the decision of the committee.

* - Applicants must be members in good standing in the Honors Program, i.e. 1) have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or better; 2) be participating in or have completed the required four colloquia (three for upper class admissions)
