2009 AWARDS

Awards will be made on the following competitive basis:

- First-year and second-year students, who are members in good-standing of the Honors Program and have a minimum 3.3 cumulative grade point average at the end of the fall semester 2008, are eligible to apply.
- Each applicant should submit one copy of the essay without identification of the author. Attach the essay to **separate cover page** with the author's name, the title of the paper, UKID number, local address, and telephone number. The paper of 1200-1500 words should address the following subject:

What text or author from HON 101/201 did you find most meaningful for understanding contemporary events and/or culture?

Submissions should be taken to the Honors Program Office, 1153 Patterson Office Tower, by the deadline.

- A jury of four faculty members will read each submission and determine the winners after an evaluation of the combined quality of the cumulative GPA and paper.

Conditions of the Scholarship: The recipient must be enrolled in the Honors Program.

The recipients will receive \$100 each at the beginning of the spring semester through Student Financial Aid. (Student Billings will figure it into your account and refund any overpayment in check form.)

Application Deadline: Monday, February 9th, 2009, by 4:00 pm
Recipients will be honored in April at the Annual Awards Ceremony.
