REQUIRED INFORMATION—VACCINATION INFORMATION ABOUT MENINGITIS

Pursuant to Kentucky Legislature house bill #342 effective July 1, 2004, UK Campus Housing is required to provide vaccination information about meningitis to full-time students living in residence housing.

What is meningococcal meningitis? Meningococcal meningitis is a rare, but potentially fatal, bacterial infection. The disease is expressed as either meningococcal meningitis, an inflammation of the membranes surround the brain and spinal cord, or meningococemia, the presence of bacteria in the blood.

Is the meningitis vaccine available at University of Kentucky Health Service? The meningitis vaccine is available for students through University Health Service.

To make an appointment, students should call (859) 323-APPT (2778). The cost of the vaccine is \$75 USD for full-time students. Part-time students who have not paid the health fee will be charged for an office visit in addition to the cost of the vaccine. Due to high demand, campus furnished living units are very limited. Housing assignments are based on availability, your specific needs, and your established priority date. The priority date is established when we receive your completed application and housing deposit. Submitting an application and deposit does NOT guarantee a housing assignment. The deposit required is \$150.00 USD. The deposit does not have to be paid in advance if you are living outside the US (Puerto Rico excluded) AND you fax your application to our office. The full deposit must be paid when you move into your apartment. All new residents will pay rent on a pro-rated basis for the month in which you move into the apartment. All payments must be made by credit or debit card, personal check, traveler's check, or money order. We do not take cash in our office. We do not take credit or debit card payments on the telephone. 1. Rent includes electricity, heat, air-conditioning where applicable, water, cable, and internet connectivity.
Telephone service is NOT included in the rates. Parking fees are NOT included in the rates.
2. All Graduate and Family Housing Apartments are equipped with basic furniture and appliances. Furnishings do not include: televisions, stereos, microwaves, washers and dryers, dishwashers, or other personal appliances. Large appliances are not allowed in the apartments. We provide laundry facilities. You will need to bring all personal linens, kitchen supplies, cleaning supplies, and other household needs.

DESCRIPTION OF GRADUATE AND FAMILY APARTMENTS

COMMONWEALTH VILLAGE: This community is reserved for single graduate or non-traditional students. You can choose from efficiency units or one bedroom apartments. The complex is located slightly over one-half mile from central campus. The apartments are centrally heated and air-conditioned; have wall-to-wall carpeting; and Venetian blinds. Laundry facilities are available. The area is served by the UK bus service.

COOPERSTOWN: This community's residents consist of single graduate and non-traditional students as well as students with families. Cooperstown is located one-half mile from central campus in close proximity to the WT Young Library. This complex is centrally heated. The majority of the apartments have air-conditioning. However, a few un-air-conditioned units are available upon request. The apartments have wall-to-wall carpeting in the living room and dining area. Venetian blinds are provided on all windows. There is a separate laundry facility for each building. Playground equipment, picnic shelters, and plenty of lawn space are available.

468 ROSE LANE: Rose Lane is reserved for single graduate or non-traditional students. It is located on a residential street adjacent to campus. These efficiency apartments are centrally heated and air-conditioned. They have wall-to-wall carpeting and Venetian blinds.

SHAWNEETOWN: This community's residents consist of single graduate and non-traditional students as well as students with families. The community is located about one mile from central campus. Your choices include: efficiency apartments as well as one or two bedroom apartments. The apartments are centrally heated and air-conditioned; have wall-to-wall carpeting in the living room; and Venetian blinds. A separate laundry facility is provided in each building. There is ample lawn space and several playgrounds in the complex.

GREG PAGE STADIUM VIEW APARTMENTS: Greg Page is located one mile from central campus. Greg Page contains only two bedroom apartments. They are centrally heated and air-conditioned. They have vertical or Venetian blinds and wall-to-wall carpeting. The apartments in Greg Page contain more square footage than our other apartments. A central laundry facility is available.

404 LINDEN WALK: The Office of International Affairs assigns International Undergraduate students to Linden Walk apartments. This small apartment community is located on a residential street adjacent to campus. The efficiency apartments are centrally heated and air-conditioned and have wall-to-wall carpeting.

DEFINITIONS

- Efficiency:** A one-room apartment with a living room and bedroom combined, small kitchen, full bath. Maximum number of family occupants is three.
- One bedroom Apartment:** Living room with a dining area, one bedroom, kitchen and full bath. Maximum number of family occupants is four.
- Two bedroom apartment:** Living room with a dining area, two bedrooms, kitchen and full bath. Maximum number of family occupants is six.
