CRIMINAL BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The University of Kentucky requires that the following questions be answered by everyone applying to live in residence halls, apartments, and Greek houses that are operated by UK Campus Housing. Applicants are not required to disclose conduct which occurred prior to their 18th birthday.

Have you ever plead guilty to, or been convicted by a judge or jury, of a felony or misdemeanor offense in Kentucky or any other state?

You must report any offense, even if probation, parole, an Alford Plea, or pretrial diversion occurred.
