

Data Clarification

1.	<p>SIS will store 4 majors and 2 minors. These elements are in the IARRCRT record and are RT120, 125, 145, and RT150 for the 4 majors.</p> <p>All students have RT120, which is the primary major. Some students will have a second major which is RT125 Some may even have a major under the second program, but few (if any) students have all 4 majors.</p> <p>The minor elements are: RT130 and RT155.</p>
2.	<p>SIS does store a "Section Site Sponsor". This is element RC370. For most course sections this field is blank. It can also be OC for off campus, RH for Rural Health, MO for Morehead...</p>
3.	<p>SIS also stores the Program Administrative Group (RC277). This field is used primarily to identify KyVU courses. If the course is a Virtual University course, the course will have a Program Administrative Group of 'KY'.</p>
4.	<p>SIS stores the Program Reporting Type (also known as "Delivery Mode"). This is how we code courses as either off-campus, TV, internet, telecommunications cable, etc.</p>

If a section of a course is not built correctly, or if section information is not conveyed to Communications and Publications in the Registrar's Office then a specific delivery mode, or site sponsor, etc, can't be entered into SIS
