Text Organization

Personnages is an intermediate-level French book. It utilizes readings and culture in order to further French language acquisition. Each chapter will focus on a different part of the Francophone world and you will encounter different characters from those readings. The book is broken up into 10 chapters (FR 201= chapters 1-5; FR 202= chapters 6-10).

This book focuses on expanding that which you have already learned in beginning-level French and utilizing new grammar concepts as well as new vocabulary.

Grading Policy

The assignments handed in will count as one-half of the final grade. The final examination will also be one-half of the final grade. **However, the student must pass the final exam with a 60% or better in order to pass the course.**

The final examination will be a written, comprehensive test of grammar, vocabulary, and reading comprehension. A detailed explanation of the final exam format and content is given after Assignment 30 in the Assignment booklet.

A percentage is used in order to determine the final grade. The following grade scale is used:
