

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT
Between
UNIVERSITY OF KENTUCKY
And
UNIVERSITY

In order to advance friendly relations between USA and _____, the University of Kentucky and _____ University join in the following agreement on the promotion of education and academic exchanges between the two universities.

Both institutions will make every reasonable effort to encourage direct contact and research cooperation between their faculty members, departments, and research institutes, to the extent that they are able, under provisions of this agreement, and endeavor to cooperate in the fields with which both parties are concerned.

Both universities agree on the following general forms of cooperation:

1. Joint research activities
2. Exchange of academic materials and academic publications
3. Exchange of faculty members for research, lectures, and discussions
4. Exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research

Themes of joint activities and conditions for utilizing the results and arrangements for specific visits, exchanges and other forms of cooperation will be negotiated in writing for each specific case.

Both universities understand that all the financial arrangements should be negotiated and will depend upon the availability of funds.

It is understood that the implementation of this agreement will commence on (signing date) and that this agreement will continue thereafter for three (3) years, subject from time to time to revision or modification by mutual agreement. The possibility and the terms of a renewal of the agreement will be discussed by the representatives of the two universities no less than six months prior to the natural termination of the current agreement.
