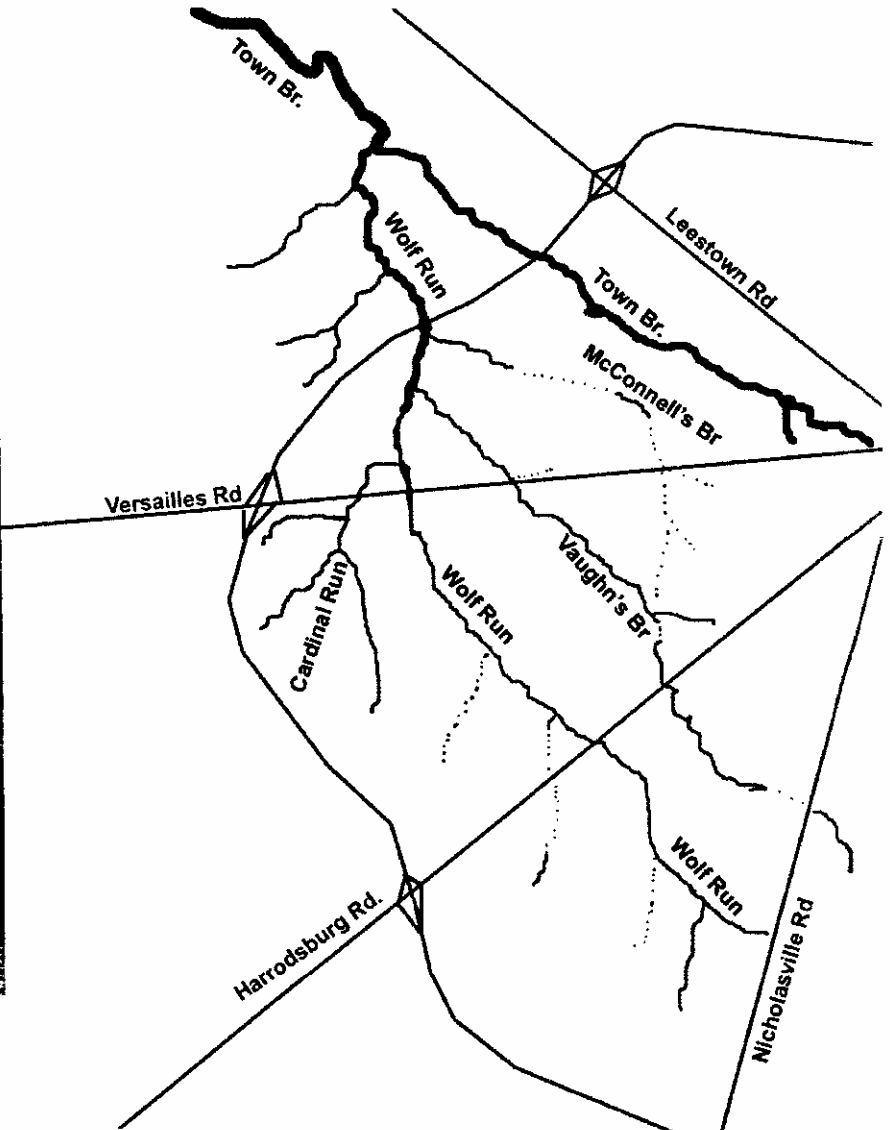

**1. Project Summary:**

Friends of Wolf Run Project involved setting up a community based watershed organization to conduct educational programs, stream monitoring and stream rehabilitation efforts. The group conducted the following activities:

1. Set up Steering Committee, incorporated in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Registered with the Fayette County Court Clerk, Developed Organizational By-Laws, Secured IRS determination of non-profit 501©3 status.
2. Set up a web site for streamside landowners:

3. Conducted a water quality roundtable inviting area experts from UK, KY Division of Water, Kentucky Geological Survey and area consulting firms to discuss and answer questions on water quality issues in the watershed.
4. Conducted a Greenways Tour in cooperation with LFUCG Division of Parks and Greenways Program.
5. Trained six volunteer monitoring teams in cooperation with Kentucky River Watershed Watch to collect samples in the watershed based on recommendations from the Water Quality Roundtable. (Nutrients, pathogens, heavy metals)
6. Conducted three rounds of sampling in the watersheds. Results reported to the LFUCG Council, membership of the organization and at a community meeting held in September of 2005.
7. Conducted a community meeting for Lafayette South Bend neighborhood to address water quality and stream management issues. Developed a tree planting campaign plan and secured \$10,000 in funding from LFUCG for plant materials and tree planting services.
8. Conducted a planning meeting for 2006, along with a creek walk and community field day attended by the Mayor of Lexington and streamside residences.
