14th Annual Sarah Bennett Holmes Award

Recognizing Remarkable Women at the University of Kentucky

*The UK Women's Forum Board seeks nominations
for the 2007 Sarah Bennett Holmes Award.*

Sarah Bennett Holmes, a distinguished former Dean of Women at the University of Kentucky, championed the rights of women and inspired young women to persevere in the face of hardship and to pursue their educational and career goals. Fourteen years ago, the University of Kentucky Women's Forum Board established the **Sarah Bennett Holmes Award**.

The **Sarah Bennett Holmes Award** is granted annually to women working at the University who promote the growth and well-being of other women at UK and across the Commonwealth. These awards bring recognition for efforts that would otherwise go unnoticed through typical channels. **Two awards will be granted:** one to a female staff member and one to a female faculty member. Each recipient receives \$1,000.00 and is announced at a ceremony presented during a luncheon for all the nominees. The awards luncheon is hosted by the **UK Women's Forum**. The 2007 Sarah Bennett Holmes Awards Luncheon will be held on March 21st. Any woman (regular staff or faculty) currently employed by the University of Kentucky is eligible for nomination. The recipient must be a UK employee on March 21, 2007, the date of the ceremony.

DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF COMPLETED NOMINATION: March 1, 2007

**Although Sarah Bennett Holmes award winners from previous years are not eligible, women nominated previously may be re-nominated for this year's award. Self-nominations are not accepted.*
