Check-In

We are looking forward to seeing you on campus for your Advising Conference on **Friday, November 20, 2009**. Conference check-in will begin at **7:30 A.M.** outside the Worsham Theatre in the Student Center. You must arrive no later than 8:00 A.M. if you need to take the Math Placement Exam. Please see the attached sheet for information on Math Placement Exam requirements and exceptions. A required Advising Conference fee of \$25 will be added to your tuition statement.

During the conference, you will meet with an academic advisor to plan your schedule and register for classes. Most students will complete the entire process by noon.

If you are unable to attend registration at this time, please use the myUK system to sign up for the January 11, 2010 Advising Conference (Freshman and Transfer) or the January 12, 2010 Advising Conference (Readmitted). **Class selection will be limited in January — you are encouraged to attend the November Conference.**

Academic advising is essential to good academic planning and success. All students meet with advisors prior to registration. An advisor signature on your registration worksheet is mandatory. If you meet with an advisor before the Advising Conference, be sure to bring the signed worksheet to this program. No students will be allowed to register without first meeting with an advisor.

***NOTE:** Students who meet the following criteria are not required to take the exam and can plan to arrive for check-in by 8:45 A.M.:

- plan to enroll in MA 108R (remedial)
- 27 math subscore on ACT or higher
- 620 math subscore or higher on SAT
- credit for MA 109 or higher either from UK or another institution
- score of 3 or higher on calculus AB/BC AP exam

Although not necessary to complete the exam, students are allowed to use their own calculator.

Attention Winter Term Students

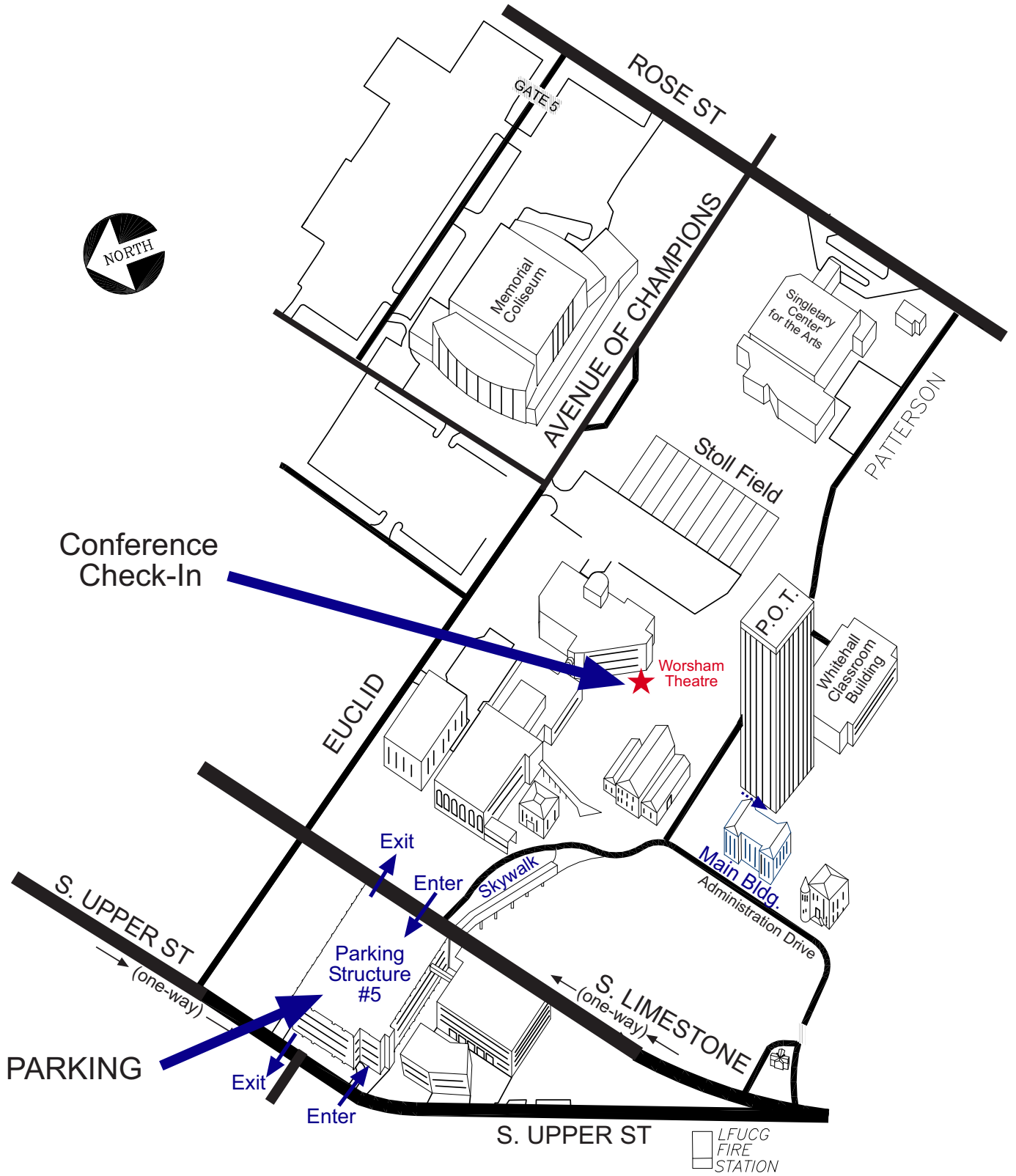

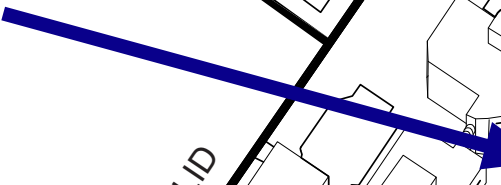

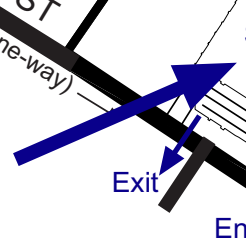

PARKING INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE ADVISING CONFERENCES

Where to Park

1. **In Parking Structure #5** – enter off Limestone or Upper Street (see map below).
2. **Parking Meters** are available for short-term parking only. The cost is 45 cents for 45 minutes. All parking meters are 24-hour controlled.

Where Not to Park

1. **E Permit** controlled zones.
2. **Handicap zones** (for UK handicapped parking information, call 257-3256).
3. **Service zones** (yellow and white striped lines).
4. **Yellow lines.**
5. **Expired meters.**

NOTE: Each University-owned parking area (street or lot) has a **permit control sign** posted near the entrance. Please comply with the information on these signs.

Parking Information

Call the Parking Office at (859) 257-5757 if you need additional information about parking on campus. Parking control officers are on duty at Gates 1, 2, 3, and 4 to assist you if you have any questions.

ROUTES TO CAMPUS/PARKING STRUCTURE #5

From the Bluegrass Parkway: Turn right off the exit onto Route 60 (Versailles Road). Follow Versailles Road until it ends. You'll bear to the right onto one-way West Maxwell Street. Proceed through two lights and at the third light turn right onto Upper Street (also one-way). Go through one traffic light; you'll notice Fazoli's Restaurant on your left. Just past the restaurant, turn left into Parking Structure #5.

From I-75 South/I-64 East or West: Take Exit 113 (marked Paris/Lexington). Turn right off the exit ramp onto North Broadway (US68). Follow through downtown for 3.5 miles. One block past the Hyatt Regency Hotel, turn left onto Maxwell Street. Proceed through two lights and at the third light turn right onto Upper Street (also one-way). Go through one traffic light; you'll notice Fazoli's Restaurant on your left. Just past the restaurant, turn left into Parking Structure #5.

From I-75 North: Take Exit 113 (marked Paris/Lexington). Follow North Broadway (US68) through downtown. One block past the Hyatt Regency Hotel, turn left onto Maxwell Street. Proceed through two lights and at the third light turn right onto Upper Street (also one-way). Go through one traffic light; you'll notice Fazoli's Restaurant on your left. Just past the restaurant, turn left into Parking Structure #5.
