PLEASE NOTE: Students admitted in Fall 2003 will enter the five-year, first-professional Bachelor of Architecture Degree Program. Beginning in Fall 2004, the School of Architecture's curriculum will change to a combined six-year program consisting of a four-year, non-professional Bachelor of Arts in Architecture degree leading to a two-year, professional Master of Architecture degree. Students admitted in Fall 2004 or later will enter the new six-year program.

The School of Architecture offers a five-year program that leads to the Bachelor of Architecture degree. The program is fully accredited by the National Architectural Accrediting Board.

Admission to the Architecture program is selective, and interested students are encouraged to make an appointment with the Associate Dean for Student Affairs of the School of Architecture.

The School of Architecture enriches its undergraduate program with a required off-campus full-credit semester. The college maintains a resident center, Atelier Veneziano, in Venice, Italy.

Candidates for the professional degree must successfully complete the requirements of the five-year curriculum, as follows:

- 1. Completion of University Studies requirements.
2. Completion of a minimum of 176 semester hours, exclusive of those earned in physical education and reserve officer training programs, with a cumulative standing of not less than 2.0.

Curriculum YEAR ONE

YEAR FOUR

Table with 2 columns: Course Name, Hours. Includes Fall Semester (ARC 820, 867, 832, University Studies Component, Elective) and Spring Semester (ARC 821, 868, 833, 836, University Studies Component).

YEAR FIVE

Table with 2 columns: Course Name, Hours. Includes Fall Semester (ARC 822, University Studies Component, Elective, ARC 869, 850, OR, ARC 899) and Spring Semester (ARC 850, University Studies Component, Elective, ARC 870, OR, ARC 901).

\*ARC 899 will be required as a preparation for the thesis. Students who enroll in ARC 899 will enroll in ARC 850 in the Spring Semester, substituting ARC 850 for an elective.

NOTE: The minimum passing grade for classes in the studio sequence shall be a grade of C.

Summer Session
