ADVISORY COUNCIL TO THE SANDERS-BROWN CENTER ON AGING

The Advisory Council to the Sanders-Brown Center on Aging shall advise the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies on the Center's program and its administration. Under applicable circumstances, the Advisory Council also recommends to the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies on the appointment of the Director to serve as the Center's chief administrative officer.

The Chancellor for the Lexington Campus, the Chancellor for the Medical Center, the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies, and the Vice Chancellor for Clinical Professional Services for the Medical Center and Dean of the College of Medicine shall serve as permanent members of the Advisory Council to the Sanders-Brown Center on Aging. Additionally, representatives from colleges and University areas which are or may be involved significantly with gerontology (such as the College of Arts and Sciences, College of Human Environmental Sciences and College of Social Work) shall be appointed by the President of the University of Kentucky to serve as members of the Advisory Council for staggered three-year terms. The Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies shall serve as chairperson of the Advisory Council.

The Advisory Council to the Sanders-Brown Center on Aging shall hold regular quarterly meetings. Special meetings of the Council may be called by the chairperson or upon written request of at least three members of the Council. Notice of each meeting shall be given by the Council's chairperson.
