UNIVERSITY DISTANCE LEARNING COMMITTEE
AND ADVISORY PANEL

The Distance Learning Committee advises the President of the University on policies governing distance learning, and advises the Director of the Distance Learning Technology Center on issues related to technology and distance learning infrastructure.

The Committee shall be composed of representatives of the two Chancellors and the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies, a faculty member outside Lexington who is associated with one of the distance learning sites and a faculty member in Lexington who is involved in distance learning. Ex-officio members of the Committee shall include the Vice President for Information Systems, the Dean of University Extension, the Director of the Distance Learning Technology Center, and the Special Assistant to the President for Academic Affairs.

An Advisory Panel of users and potential users of distance learning delivery systems will meet at least once annually with the Committee to provide advice on issues that emerge or that are potential concerns. Members of the Advisory Panel shall include three Deans, the Director of the Center on Rural Health, and a member of the Continuing Education Council.

The President of the University appoints the Distance Learning Committee and the Advisory Panel members.
