## UNIVERSITY COMMITTEE ON PRESS, RADIO, AND TELEVISION

### I. Introduction

The University Committee on Press, Radio, and Television provides advice and counsel to the University on media-related matters and on broadcast contracts and publishing rights related to University athletic events. The Committee serves both the University and the University of Kentucky Athletic Association.

### II. Membership

- A. The Committee is appointed by the President and shall be comprised of members from the faculty and staff.
- B. The Chair and ex officio members shall be designated by the President.
- C. Members other than those with ex officio status shall have staggered three-year appointments.

### III. Responsibilities

- A. The Committee provides advice and counsel on media-related matters of the University. In this area, the Committee reports to the Executive Director of Public Relations and shall maintain written minutes of meetings and, on request, shall prepare special reports for the Executive Director of Public Relations.
- B. The Committee provides advice and counsel to the Director of Athletics and the University of Kentucky Athletic Association Board of Directors in matters dealing with contracting broadcast and publishing rights for University athletic events. On these matters, the Committee works with University Purchasing to develop bid invitations, evaluates bids, and makes recommendations with regard to acceptance or rejection of bids.
