COMMITTEE ON INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

I. Introduction

The Committee on International Students advises and, at the Provost's request, assists the Director of the Office of International Affairs in efforts to integrate international students into the campus and larger community. The Committee also shall consider any special problems and proposals relative to international students which are referred to it by the Provost.

II. Membership

A. The Committee is appointed by and reports to the Provost.

B. Committee membership shall be comprised of faculty, staff, and students. The chair and ex officio members shall be designated by the Provost. The Committee members other than those with student or ex officio status normally shall have staggered three-year appointments.

III. Responsibilities

A. In carrying out its responsibilities, the Committee shall consult with and make recommendations to all units of the University that are involved in the issues related to international students.

B. The Committee, in accordance with criteria and guidelines proposed by the Committee and approved by the Provost, also shall recommend to the Director of the Office of International Affairs on recipients of University scholarships for international students.

C. Other concerns or matters on which the Committee may advise or make recommendations shall include, but not necessarily be limited to, the following:

1. The establishment of the organizational responsibility and operations of the Office of International Affairs;
2. The number, preparation, and origin of international students at the University, and related admissions policies and procedures;

3. The general welfare of international students and their integration into the University and larger community;

4. The assistantships, loans, and non-scholarship awards for international students; and

5. The systematic involvement of international students in communicating knowledge regarding their countries and cultures to other students, faculty, staff, and the community.

D. The Committee shall maintain written minutes of meetings and, on request, shall prepare reports for the Provost.
