SATURDAY, JUNE 6	Arrival in Mexico City – transport to Morelia ; picked up by families
SUNDAY, JUNE 7	Tour of Morelia ; Day with families; Welcome dinner at UNLA (Universidad Latina de América)
MONDAY, JUNE 8	Morelia : <u>Presentation</u> (1.5hrs): The Impact of Migration on Mexico and discussion <u>Visit</u> : Elementary Schools <u>Presentation</u> (2 hrs) Mexican Family/Culture, Education, Medical & Social Service Systems
TUESDAY, JUNE 9	<u>Excursion/Visits</u> : Tarímbaro : village with high migration rates, economic/social conditions & schools/clinics; Tzintzuntzan : bi-lingual & special needs schools, culture, handicrafts, and ruins. Patzcuaro : culture, indigenous crafts, museum.
WEDNESDAY, JUNE 10	<u>Excursion/Visits</u> : Tarascon : government social development programs, migration issues; Santa Clara : culture, copper handicrafts; Lago Zirahuen
THURSDAY, JUNE 11	<u>Excursion</u> : Erongarícuaro : furniture making, education, migration, Corpus Cristi fiesta; La Zarzamora : medical clinic (1970's & migration)
FRIDAY, JUNE 12	<u>Excursion</u> : Calabozo/Senguio : Migration affected village (social development project), participate in village activities & food preparation; explore human services (schools, healthcare).
SATURDAY, JUNE 13	Morelia : Reception (lunch) at university (UNLA); proposed visit by Beatriz Zavala, recent Secretary of Social Development in Mexico's President Calderon's Cabinet & UK graduate (sociology) to discuss social development and migration in Mexico. Discussion of bilateral solutions to migration. Evening with host family.
