Participation Terms and Conditions Release and Agreement

I am an applicant for the Ultimate Home Visit 2009. I understand that this project involves travel to Morelia, Michoacan, Mexico and surrounding region. I acknowledge and agree to the following conditions binding upon myself and upon my agency or source of funds.

1. The Ultimate Home Visit project cannot be responsible for events beyond its control, including without limitation, acts of nature, war, strikes or government restrictions, or any other circumstances of force majeure; nor, for personal injury, accidents, death, property damage or loss, delay caused by persons, including, without limitation, airlines, bus companies, taxis, or any other agency, company, or individual.

The Ultimate Home Visit project is not responsible for loss of travel documents or airline tickets, loss or damage to luggage or any other personal belongings, or for consequential damages in any event.

2. Included in the cost of the trip are administrative fees, university fees, ground transportation for program group excursions, accommodations and meals with a host family. Neither the Project nor its administrators are responsible for my travel to and from Mexico.
3. If I become ill, injured, or incapacitated during the trip, I will obtain medical treatment at my expense. If it is necessary for me to return to Lexington, I will make my own arrangements to do so at my own expense. I am responsible for obtaining any necessary/additional insurance for travel in Mexico and for any costs incurred for medical treatment as a result of this project. (The Project strongly recommends participants obtain travel and health insurance.)
4. The Ultimate Home Visit is not responsible for me when I am absent from scheduled activities or otherwise. I accept liability for any financial obligations incurred by me, or any damage or injury caused by me while on the trip.
5. If I withdraw from the trip, I must do so individually in writing. I understand the attached Drop Out and Waiting List policy and that money I put toward the trip is non-refundable. However, I may obtain the name of someone or an organization on the waiting list as a substitute, and it will be my responsibility to make any necessary arrangements for substitution.
6. A \$200 nonrefundable deposit must accompany applications. Full payment is due no later than **April 1, 2009**. Failure to pay the balance by this date may result in loss of deposit and participation in the project. Payment will be made by agency or personal check only, payable to **LexLinc, Inc.** (Fiscal Agent for this project), which is located at 436 Georgetown Street, Lexington, Kentucky 40508, attention Wanda Bertram. **Purchase orders are not accepted for deposits or final payments.** The application form and this release for The Ultimate Home Visit must accompany initial payment.

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Drop Out and Wait List Policy

1. Prior to April 1, 2009, deposits and applications will be accepted. If over twenty applications are filed, additional applications can be put on a waiting list and deposits held (not cashed).
2. If one of the initial twenty applicants drops out before April 1 or does not make full payment by April 1, the next person on the list will be notified, may have their deposit cashed and make full payment immediately.
3. After April 1, all remaining deposits will be returned. These individuals will also be notified that they may still be contacted in the event a participant drops out.
4. After full payment, a participant dropping out is responsible for directly contacting potential substitutes and making arrangements for substitution and payment/reimbursement. All negotiations for substitution and reimbursement will take place between these two parties and is not the responsibility of the Ultimate Home Visit project.
5. Any withheld deposits or other collected unspent funds will be spent on appropriate Mexican organizations or schools that are visited while in Mexico after administrative fees are paid.
