**Train:** Amtrak is located in Union Station, a hub that links trains with Metro, Circulator and taxi options. If you choose to ride Amtrak. Conference participants can receive a 10% discount. The Dupont Circle Metro Station, located on the Red Line is four blocks from the Washington Hilton Hotel, the Conference site. Exit at the north end of the station to Q Street, walk four blocks north on Connecticut Avenue, NW to the Hotel at 1919 Connecticut Avenue, NW.
