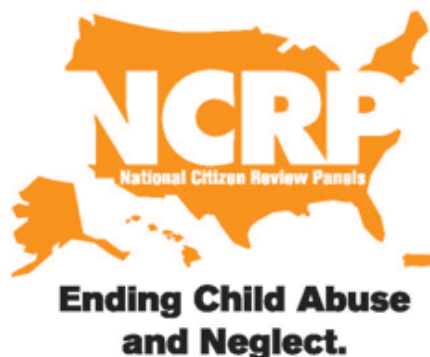


The Power of Community



*National Citizen Review Panel Advisory Panel Teleconference Notes
April 13, 2010*

The quarterly conference call of the National CRP Advisory Board was held on this date.

Conference Update

There are approximately 54 people registered for the National Conference. Blake was hoping to have 100 at the conference, but it may be less than that (perhaps closer to 75). The conference has been advertised on the national listserv several times as well as on other national web sites. There are a number of people who have committed to coming but have not yet registered.

Facebook Page

Blake said that the National CRP Facebook page has become a forum for some very inflammatory language as was wondering how he could better police the content. Catherine suggested that the folks at the Children's Bureau could be helpful as they also maintain a Facebook page. It was suggested that it may be helpful to close the page to outside comments or allow only CRP members to log on.
