**Educational Focus:** Students will participate in 4.5 days of academic program at the premiere Tavistock Clinic. A program of lectures, discussions, live client observations, and research & reading focus groups focusing on child and adolescent treatment. Renowned faculty members from the Tavistock will present a variety of topics, including: Attachment Across the Lifecycle, Adoption & Fostering, Adolescent Psychotherapy, Assessment, Family Therapy, Infant Mental Health, Adolescents at Risk of Suicide & Self-Harm, Groups, etc.

This program is also available for UK alumni, and other interested professionals. CEUs will be offered for the academic program. Students can earn 3 hrs credit by registering for SOCW 580.

**Location:** The program includes nine days in London, England, including two days of guided tours outside of the London area. Accommodations at the Holiday Inn in Camden Lock (3-star hotel).

**Cultural Program:** Opportunities for tourism to visit well-known and unique places of interest are included in the tour package: St. Paul's Cathedral, Trafalgar Square, Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Changing of the Guard, Windsor Castle, Hampton Court Palace, Stratford-on-Avon, Oxford University, & the Cotswolds.

**Costs:** Approximate cost per person for Students is: \$2,583.50, and for UK Alumni is: \$2,833.50 (includes UK program fee); Cost includes roundtrip Delta airfare from Cincinnati airport to London Gatwick, airport taxes; roundtrip transfers from London airport to hotel accommodations (double ) & 9 continental breakfasts; special "Welcome Dinner," Tavistock academic program including 5 lunches & various tea, coffee & "biscuits" breaks; 9 day London Travelcard pass on the "tube;" guided bus tour of London, full day tour of Windsor Castle and Hampton Court Palace, full day tour of Stratford, Oxford University, & the Cotswolds; health insurance; service charges & local taxes



### Payment Schedule & Registration:

Places on this tour are limited to 12 participants. Reservations will be made on a first come first confirmed basis and payment of \$200 registration deposit (non-refundable) by **January 24, 2003**. Second payment for Students is \$1,404.25 and for UK Alumni/Professionals is \$1,554.25 due by **February 14, 2003**. Final payment for Students is \$979.25 and for UK Alumni/Professionals is \$1,079.25 due by **March 31, 2003**. If you are taking this for UK credit, registration should be done at the appropriate time for the first four-week Summer session 2003.
