University of Kentucky Sorority Recruitment Registration Form

To assure your understanding of important policies affecting the recruitment process and pledging, you are requested to read and sign the following statement. I understand that:

1. Except for illness or emergency, I must participate in all recruitment functions and attend invitational functions which I have accepted. Late registration or late arrival may diminish possibilities of pledging.
2. Although Panhellenic does not require a specific grade point average to participate in the recruitment week process, each of the women's fraternity chapters has a minimum grade point average for pledging. These are a 3.0 on a 4.0 scale for high school or range from a 2.5 to a 3.2 for college. I understand that if my grade point average is below the minimum, chances of pledging are low. Some chapters require a college grade point average in order to initiate or to remain an active member. All participants must be full-time students on the Lexington campus.
3. I agree that the Panhellenic Council may verify my cumulative GPA from my high school and/or any college I have attended, along with my American College Test (ACT) or Scholastic Assessment Test (SAT) scores, and that this information may be released to the individual sororities.
4. Alcohol and illegal drugs are prohibited from use during Fall Membership Recruitment. The Panhellenic Council will handle violations of Kentucky Law and University policy. This can also result in dismissal from the residence hall and the membership recruitment program.
5. The University of Kentucky and Panhellenic Association are not responsible for the loss, theft of, or damage to personal property of the students.
6. I understand that if I live in university housing during the formal sorority recruitment week that I will be charged on my UK billing account \$102.00.
7. I understand that I am encouraged to attend the maximum number of functions that I can each day of membership recruitment in order to maximize my chances of pledging. I realize that sororities are notified of my absences from any function during membership recruitment. Skipping functions to which I have accepted an invitation will be looked upon with disfavor by all chapters.
8. I understand that the information in this application will be made available to active and alumnae members of sororities at UK and to alumnae members of sororities in my hometown, which is for the purpose of obtaining references on my behalf. I also understand that my Gamma Chi, the UK Panhellenic recruitment staff, and the NPC recruitment specialist will have access to my recruitment selections and that they will keep this information confidential.
9. I verify that I have never been initiated by a National Panhellenic Conference member sorority and that I have not pledged a National Panhellenic Conference member sorority at the University of Kentucky within the past calendar year.
10. I reserve the right to pledge no fraternity if, in the end of the recruitment week period, that seems best to me; but if I am offered a bid to one of the fraternities that I have listed on my preference card following the preference function round and do not accept, then I am ineligible to join any other National Panhellenic Conference fraternity at the University of Kentucky for one calendar year.

I have read and understand the above regulations and agree to abide by these rules throughout my stay on campus. Infractions or violations of these regulations could result in termination of membership recruitment privileges and requirement to move out of the residence hall.
