4 p.m. – 5 p.m. New Student Induction Ceremony

Students, family members, and guests are invited to join President Lee T. Todd, Jr. and other members of the University community to commemorate the start of a new school year. All new students are expected to attend this annual University celebration to be inducted into the UK family. Parents, families, and guests are encouraged to attend.

5 p.m. – 6:45 p.m. Free Time
