

# **THIS IS LEXINGTON!**

## **Instructions**

Welcome to Lexington! This game is designed to offer information for new students and allow them to have fun while learning about their new home. This game can be used during a full class period or half of one.

- Divide students into three or four teams and have them select team captains.
- The team captain will be responsible for conferring with team members and submitting answers throughout the game.
- Distribute handouts to each student in the class. Game categories correspond with sections on the handout. Students are allowed to use the handout to formulate a response.
- The game is played like the television version of “Jeopardy!” You will find a game board and answers/questions included in the lesson plan.
- Select one of the teams to choose first. They will select a category and an answer, which will then be open to all teams. Whichever team “buzzes in” first has an opportunity to respond. Their response should be in the form of a question. If they respond incorrectly, the other teams can then buzz in. Whichever team responds correctly gains control of the board and can choose the next answer.
- Each correct response earns the assigned number of points for the team that got it right—or subtracts the assigned number of points for any team that got it wrong.
- Keep track of each team’s score on the blackboard.
- At the beginning of the second round, the team with the fewest points selects first.
- At the end of the second round, allow the teams time to decide their wagers for the final question. The team captains must write their team’s wager on a slip of paper and turn it in to you.
- Once the Final Jeopardy answer is given, the teams will have 60 seconds to come up with the correct question—which must be submitted to you in writing.
- Read each team’s response out loud to the class and then add or subtract the amount of their wager to their score based on whether their response was correct.
- In the end, the team with the highest score is the winner.

- 100 – A. After a pizza dinner, you may decide to play skee ball or ride the carousel at this local eatery.  
Q. What is Gatti-Town?
- 200 – A. At this place you can win money, place bets, and show off your fashion sense.  
Q. What is Keeneland?
- 300 – A. This is the largest movie theater in Lexington.  
Q. What is Regal (Hamburg Movie Theaters)?
- 400 – A. Midnight movies on the weekend are a popular attraction at this historic downtown theater.  
Q. What is the Kentucky Theater?
- 500 – A. This fun spot includes ice skating, putt-putt golf, and the home games of the UK Hockey team.  
Q. What is Lexington Ice Center?

### **Food:**

- 100 – A. This pizza place is popular among college students and is located next to Jimmy John's.  
Q. What is Pazzo's?
- 200 – A. These 2 burrito restaurants are just a short walk from campus.

- 600 – A. This outdoor shopping complex has a Walmart, Target, Meijer, Lowe's, and many restaurants and stores for all of your needs.  
Q. What is Hamburg Pavilion?
- 800 – A. You can check out locally owned stores at this complex before a men's basketball game.  
Q. What is Victorian Square?
- 1000 – A. You've hit the bull's eye if you know that this store is located on Nicholasville Road and also at Hamburg Pavilion.  
Q. What is Target?

### **Find it at UK:**

- 200 – A. In this building, named after a former UK President, students can gather for concerts, exhibits, lectures, and other performances.  
Q. What is the Singletary Center for the Arts?
- 400 – A. If a student wanted to buy stamps, send mail, or get a free mailbox without leaving campus, they could go here.  
Q. Where is the UK Post Office (basement of the White Hall classroom building)?
- 600 – A. You can get help with your papers, make copies, find a book, and enjoy a spicy beef wrap in this building.  
Q. What is the W.T. Young Library?
- 800 – A. WRFL, UK's student-run radio station, is located here.  
Q. Where is the Student Center? (1<sup>st</sup> floor)
- 1000 – A. Students can climb the wall and help power the University in this facility.  
Q. What is the Johnson Recreation Center?

### **Heart of the City:**

- 200 – A. This university is the oldest school in Kentucky.  
Q. What is Transylvania University?
- 400 – A. During August, Septembers, and October, many people attend horse races at this track located about a mile from campus  
Q. What is Red Mile Harness Track?
- 600 – A. This park, located downtown, has fountains that light up at night.  
Q. What is Triangle Park?
- 800 – A. This historical site is the family home of a former U.S. First Lady.  
Q. What is the Mary Todd Lincoln House?
- 1000 – A. As far as we know, there are no phantoms haunting this downtown arts center.
