

## **Residence Hall Check-in Policy**

All guests, including family members and students who live in University housing, must register at the front desk and be escorted by their host at all times while in the building. In addition, guests are required to leave their own picture identification at the front desk, which will be returned when the guest leaves the hall.

Please note that while the policy typically limits each resident to two guests at a time, during Family Weekend additional guests will be allowed as long as they are family members.

## **Residence Hall Visitation Policy**

Different residence halls have different visitation policies, so please pay attention to the policy that governs the hall(s) you may be visiting during Family Weekend.

In all co-ed halls, “in-hall” visitation (students who live in the same hall visiting each other) will be permitted 24 hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week. In addition, the visitation policy in co-ed halls will be gender neutral (no distinctions as to gender). Please see rationale listed below.

Two different visitation options will be offered in co-ed halls:

Option 1 (24-7): Guests from outside the hall (regardless of gender) will be permitted to visit 24 hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week. This policy applies to the following halls: Keeneland Hall, Patterson Hall, Blanding II, Blanding III, Kirwan II, Kirwan III and Kirwan IV.

Option 2 (24-Hour Weekends): Guests from outside the hall (regardless of gender) will be permitted to visit from Noon – Midnight, Monday – Thursday, then 24 hours-a-day from Friday at Noon until Sunday at Midnight. This policy will apply to the following halls: Holmes Hall, Blanding I, Blanding IV, Blanding Tower, Kirwan Tower, Smith Hall, Ingels Hall, Baldwin Hall, Jewell Hall and North Hall.

In all single gender halls, the visitation policy will be gender-specific. In these halls, visitation by members of the same gender, whether they live in the hall or not, will be permitted 24 hours-a-day, 7 days-a-week.

Three different visitation options will be offered in single gender residence halls:

Option 1 (24-7): Guests of the opposite gender will be permitted to visit 24 hours-a day, 7 days-a-week. This policy will apply to the following halls: Sigma Chi fraternity, Phi Delta Theta Fraternity, and Sigma Alpha Epsilon Fraternity.

Option 2 (24-Hour Weekends): Guests of the opposite gender will be permitted to visit from Noon – Midnight, Monday – Thursday, and then 24 hours-a-day from Friday at Noon until Sunday at Midnight. This policy will apply to the following halls: Blazer Hall, Donovan Hall, Haggin Hall, and 441 Penn.

Option 3: Guests of the opposite gender will be permitted to visit from Noon – Midnight, Sunday – Thursday, and from Noon – 2:00 am, Friday – Saturday. This policy will apply to the following halls: Kirwan I, Wildcat Lodge, and Sigma Kappa Sorority. (Sigma Kappa has restricted visitation and only family members are able to visit in student rooms.)
